

SESSION 1 WEDNESDAY ELECTIVES 2022

Session Dates: Sept. 21, 28, Oct. 5, 12, 19, 26

Orienteering -Class Fee \$10. Students will be introduced to the "EAS Sport" of Orienteering. Students explore different nearby parks and wooded areas over the six weeks. Orienteers learn how to get unlost, find their way, develop their lateral thinking skills, and problem solve in a real world environment. With an orienteering mindset, you'll always know when your GPS is leading you astray and you'll learn how to plan ahead. Students will be introduced to Orienteering at Camp Hamilton so this elective is a great extension for those interested. Net Sports - Class Fee \$25. Let's continue enjoying this wonderful summer weather while we can with some outdoor fun! This class will be focused on beach volleyball, badminton, pickleball, and variations to keep things interesting! Magic The Gathering & Board Games- Class Fee \$25. Come join the Magic card game craze. Magic the Gathering is a card game where you build your collection of cards by trading with your friends, assembling decks of cards, and battling against an opponent and their deck. This class is suited for those who have never played but want to learn as well as the more advanced player. Not into Magic but enjoy strategy board games? Then this elective is for you too. Each week there will be a variety of board games available to learn and play. Class taught by Eric Battisti of Tolarian Scholars Northwest. Eric has taught several enrichment classes at EAS as well as other afterschool programs. Eric is a Magic the Gathering expert as well as provides a variety of new and fun board games for students. **Class taught at EAS - Parent chaperones needed, sign up below**

Golf - Class Fee \$50*. This elective will be a combination of instruction, driving range practice, and 2 weeks out on the golf course. The first 2 weeks students will have golf instruction at Redwood Golf Range with their golf pro. Instruction will be structured for the beginner and intermediate junior golfer. Students will learn the golf stance, swing motions, rules and etiquette. Students will do some practice at Redwood Golf Range which features a double decker driving range with heated stalls and a putting green. Finally students will have the opportunity to put their skills to work playing at Willows Golf Course, Heron Links 9 hole course. **Parent Chaperones and Carpool Drivers will be needed on several weeks - sign up below.** Fee includes instruction and driving range fees. *Cost to play at Willows is not included in the class fee. Students will pay Willows directly (approximately, \$13-\$16 dollars per student).

Guitar - Class Fee \$50. Want to learn to play the basics on guitar? Already know how to play but want to learn and practice more? This class could be for you. Join Mr. Kurt on Wednesdays and begin, or continue, the life-long enjoyment of playing the guitar. If there is student interest, students will also learn some beginning music composition. Mr. Kurt has taught guitar lessons for over 25 years. He has taught both beginning students and intermediate to advanced. Students will need to bring a guitar each week to class. This can be a purchased or rented guitar. Several music stores in the area rent instruments. Class will run approximately 1 to 1.5 hours (longer if music composition is of interest), students will be expected to do quiet study (homework or reading) the remaining time. Dance - No Class Fee. In this fun dance elective students will be learning a dance to Thriller as part of the Thrill the World, an annual worldwide simultaneous "Thriller" dance that takes place in October. No previous dance experience necessary, all levels welcome. Students will learn new parts of the dance each week to culminate in the optional participation in the Thrill the World performance with others on Saturday October 29th. Disc Golf -Class Fee \$60. Disc golf is a flying disc sport in which players throw a disc (similar to a frisbee) at a standing target, using rules similar to golf. In this exciting, new elective students will learn the basics of disc golf one week at a time. The final week, or two, students will travel to a disc golf course and play to give a real feel of the sport. Each student will receive one disc to keep at the end of the program. **Parent Chaperones and Carpool Drivers will be needed on final 1-2 weeks - sign up below.**
