

Robinson Arena has the hardest and fastest ice in Maine, not to mention recently renovated locker rooms and heated spectator seating.





But no one needs to be an expert to enjoy the winter here. Every day is the perfect time to try something new and just have fun in the snow!






















WELL ROUNDED.


