OFF-CAMPUS CLINICAL EXPERIENCE PERMISSION FORM

Career and Technical education offers students the opportunity to acquire skills that prepare them for successful career entry, advancement and/or continuing education.

One primary objective for career and technical education programs is to provide both school and work-based learning experiences.

Students gain real-world experiences through practical application. Dependent upon the program, clinical/work experiences often take place off-campus. It is expected that all students will participate in clinical/work experiences. Typically, students are bused to clinical/work locations. Some programs do not have busing available. These students will need the permission to provide their own transportation to the clinical/work site.

In addition to any clinical/work site requirements such as physicals, immunization records, etc., the following are required for all students who participate in off-campus clinical/work experiences:

- A copy of working papers if the student is under 18
- A copy of the student's driver license if the student has permission to drive to the clinical/work site (when busing is not provided)

It is understood that by signing this form you are acknowledging and providing permission for the student to be transported off campus to a clinical/work location. Additionally, the student understands that they must provide a copy of their driver license (if applicable) and working papers.
