Community

Radnor Township is located 13 miles west of Philadelphia and has a popula-tion of approximately 31,000. Radnor Township covers nearly 14 square miles and serves a diverse, multicultural population.

Curriculum

The following is a breakdown of requirements for the class of 2023: 4 credits of English; 3 credits each of Social Studies, Math and Science; 2 credits of Arts & Humanities electives; 0.5 credit of Physical Education; 1 credit of Health; 0.5 credit of Technology or Business; 4 credits of additional electives. This totals a minimum of 22.5 credits.

Instructional Levels

Students are grouped by instructional levels in all academic departments: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science and World Languages. Advanced Placement (AP), Integrated (Interdisciplinary English & Social Studies) and Seminar (math only) level courses are considered the most rigorous courses in the core disciplines, followed by Honors (H), Advanced (A) and College Preparatory (CP).

National Merit Recognition 2022

The RHS Class of 2022 was proud to include 3 National Merit Scholarship winners, 17 National Merit Scholarship Finalists, 17 National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists, and 44 National Merit Scholarship Commended Students.

College Board Advanced Placement Recognition

In May 2022, 490 RHS students took 1,175 AP exams. Over 87% of Radnor AP students scored a 3 or higher.
