Comparing 2021 to 2022 Results

Overall Proficiency Increased 10.4 points

Every Proficiency Measure from this year is **higher** than last year

Reading in grades 3-8: Increased 7.9 points

Math in grades 3-8: Increased 13.8 points

Science in grades 5, 8: Increased 6.9 points

HS Math 1: Increased 27.1 points

HS Math 3: Increased 15.3 points

HS Biology: Increased 3.0 points

HS English 2: Increased 2.0 points



Analysis

DCS is closing the COVID achievement gap.

DCS is on track to return to pre-pandemic proficiency levels by the end of this school year.

All schools increased proficiency from 2021 to 2022.

FFMS experienced **exemplary** results.

Each school has areas to celebrate and opportunities for continuous improvement.

Overall, DCS is moving in a positive direction.
