**Public Participation**

The School Board will, as a matter of policy, protect the legal rights to privacy and due process of employees and students. Students have a right to privacy of educational records, and educational data regarding district students will not be discussed in a public board meeting. Persons speaking on such matters will be asked to discontinue such comments.

- A. Public Hearing on the issue of the re-employment of Cheryl Hoops during her SERS service retirement.

Grace Sidaras explained her experience at Brookville High as a member of the LGBTQIA community.

Rebecca Mumford expressed her concern over school safety in light of the recent school violence in Texas. She expressed her want for the school to be fenced in and more resources for mental health.

Jared Black expressed his appreciation for school staff and administration. Mr. Black expressed his concern with the curriculum and wants the District to implement more conservative values.

Jessica Wells recommended various books and resources be made available at the school libraries on topics of LGBTQIA.

Hank Gebhart expressed his concern over adding LGBTQIA into the curriculum at the schools.

Debra Bronson expressed her concern about having proper foundations for children and is concerned about LGBTQIA topics at certain ages.

Addison Kern expressed her gratitude with the board that conversations are happening regarding LGBTQIA topics. She said she never felt forced into learning these topics by Brookville staff.

Bonnie Bertelsan has grandchildren in the school system and stated that schools should be open to all students regardless of orientation.

Susan Hoover expressed her frustration that no administrators or Board members attend Miami Valley CTC and there is a lack of communication between CTC and the High School.

Julie Russell expressed that the community is supportive of Brookville Schools Staff. It is not the job of a teacher to teach sexual orientation.

Jordan Warner expressed that there are other avenues to obtain materials regarding LGBTQIA materials. No student should be bullied and those who do bully should be reprimanded.

Brad Sidaras expressed being grateful for the foundation the community provides for students. Support for all students and leadership is key to successful students.
