<p>TECHNOLOGY</p> <p><u>Dual Credit:</u> Only applies to students who are taking Dual Credit classes during the time of the SLED day. Must provide documentation of the work completed. This option can be used for the number of Dual Credit courses a student is enrolled in.</p> <p><u>Apex Learning:</u> Only applies to students enrolled in Apex courses.
