

9/14/22: Wildcat Fans! Here's the latest news and update from the LN Athletic Department!

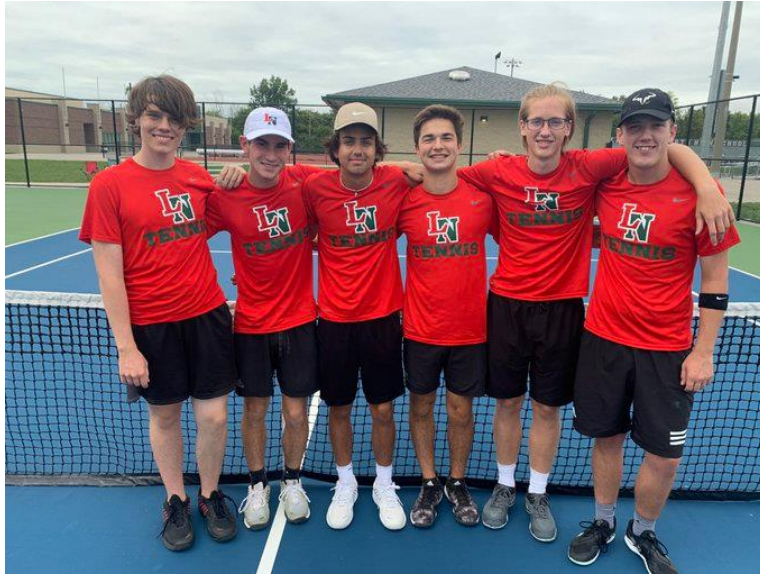
