Teacher Student Success Plan (TSSP)

1. **Reading Goal:** Fifty-seven percent of students in grades kindergarten through third will achieve typical or better growth from the beginning of year Acadience Reading to end of year Acadience Pathways of Progress Growth Measurement.
2. **Math Goal:** Students in grades 3-6 will increase overall proficiency by 3% on RISE math testing, from 45% to 48%.
3. **Culture and Climate Goal:** West Point Elementary will create an environment in which all learners feel safe and valued. We will help students develop skills of self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision making. These skills will support learners to increasing academic proficiency in literacy and mathematics.
