# Multi-Tiered Systems of Support

## WHAT IS TIER 1 INSTRUCTION?

High-quality, culturally responsive, evidence based core instruction provided by highly qualified teachers.

## WHAT EVIDENCE IS USED FOR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE TIER 1 INSTRUCTION?

MAP Benchmark Assessment-3 times per year (Fall, Winter, Spring)

- Kindergarten-2nd grade students score in the 65-100th percentile
- 3rd-6th grade students score 50-100th percentile

Classroom formative assessments by teachers  
 Classroom summative assessments by teachers  
 F&P reading data by classroom teachers

## TIER 1 INSTRUCTION PROVIDES:

- Explicit instruction with modeling
- Scaffolded instruction
- Multiple opportunities to practice and respond
- Immediate and effective feedback
- Use of multiple grouping formats
- Differentiated instruction
- Tier 1 students receive enrichment activities

## WHAT IS TIER 2 INSTRUCTION?

Strategic interventions provided to students who are not meeting benchmarks through core instruction. Strategic interventions supplement the instruction in core instruction provided in Tier 1 and should be strategic for the student's area of deficit.

## WHAT EVIDENCE IS USED FOR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE TIER 2 INSTRUCTION?

MAP Benchmark Assessment-3 times per year (Fall, Winter, Spring)

- Kindergarten-2nd grade students score in the 11-64th percentile
- 3rd-6th grade students score 11-49th percentile

 Classroom summative assessments by teachers  
 F&P reading data by classroom teachers

## TIER 2 INSTRUCTION PROVIDES:

- Tier 1 instruction -PLUS-
- Weekly intervention necessary
- Research supported interventions
- Scheduled time for additional instruction
- Progress monitoring
- Grade-level PLC and MTSS team intervention strategy discussions
- Daytime Waiver Tutoring or After School Tutoring

## WHAT IS TIER 3 INSTRUCTION?

interventions that are more intensive to the student's individual academic needs and the student's progress is monitored more frequently.

- Classroom summative assessments by teachers
- F&P reading data by classroom teachers

## TIER 3 INSTRUCTION PROVIDES:

- Tier 1 instruction and Tier 2 Interventions -PLUS-
- Small group instruction
- Intensive, more individualized instruction
