

John Carroll education is an experience that sets young people up for a lifetime of success in learning, leadership, and service.

John Carroll's enrollment has increased more than 10% in the past two years and continues to be the most diverse high school student population in the Birmingham Metro. Each year, our enrollment footprint has expanded as we welcome families from across Central Alabama. We currently serve students coming to us from more than 29 different communities spread across seven counties.

John Carroll accepts applications from all schools (public, private, and homeschool) but maintains a special relationship with the Birmingham Catholic elementary and middle schools. Our Lady of the Valley, St. Francis Xavier, Holy Family Catholic Academy, Our Lady of Sorrows, Prince of Peace, and St. Rose Academy are our partners in the mission to deliver an educational foundation rooted in Christ. We are proud to work with this coalition of parishes, school leaders, and teachers to bring an excellent K-12 Catholic education to a vibrant Catholic community.

Marked by growth in character and virtue, combined with high academic standards, John Carroll students are change-makers who are guided by the beauty of the Faith in all that they do. A John Carroll education goes beyond the rigors of the classroom as we seek to educate and inspire the whole person: spiritually, academically, creatively, and athletically.

As the 75th graduating class from John Carroll Catholic High School, the Class of 2022 will be remembered as one that achieved many outstanding milestones, overcoming significant challenges and leaving their mark on the history of the school. 



JOHN CARROLL TODAY HOW WE'RE FORMED

In the great Catholic educational tradition, the spiritual life suffuses all we do at John Carroll. Opportunities for worship, service, leadership, and spiritual growth for all students sets John Carroll apart with Campus Ministry as a cornerstone experience for Cavaliers.

Students participate in weekly student-led school Masses, First Friday Mass and Adoration, through the offering of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, through our morning and afternoon prayers, and through visits (collectively and individually) to our beautiful school Chapel.

Our community is further strengthened by our grade level retreats, by our virtue-based SportsLeadership program, through Praise and Worship Nights, by attending the annual March for Life (in Washington D.C. and in Birmingham) and by Kairos (upper class retreat) and Metanoia (underclass retreat).

The Campus Ministry program forms the heart and soul of service and discipleship at John Carroll. Whether acting as Peer Mentors, participating in Sodality (female students) or Bible Study (male students), our students have the chance to grow and share their love of Christ with one another.

John Carroll's faculty includes two Dominican sisters of St. Cecilia (Nashville), a full-time director of Campus Ministry, a priest Campus Chaplain, and two more priests serving in school leadership. Together, they work as a team to lead the spiritual direction of the school. This year, 5 JCCHS students were welcomed into full-communion with the Catholic Church and another 5 were confirmed.

JOHN CARROLL TODAY HOW WE SERVE

A John Carroll education is one that involves formation of the total person. During each student's four years at John Carroll they will be challenged to grow physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually, and a major part of this growth in these areas happens through their time in service to others.

At John Carroll, our faith in God is manifested through our love, concern, and service for others. By reaching out, we learn and understand more about the needs of others. Our talents, so often taken for granted, become more appreciated and developed. With Jesus as our model, we are encouraged to give back to our communities through the gifts that God has given us.

During the 2021-2022 school year John Carroll began its inaugural Sophomore Serve Day. This day, which will be set aside each year in early September, involves 10th grade students fanning out across the greater Birmingham area to spend a day in service to various Catholic parishes and numerous non-profit organizations.

At graduation, the Cavalier student has achieved considerable knowledge of the many needs of our school and local community - helping prepare them for the day when they will become the competent and concerned leaders of their own families, businesses, and communities.

This past year Cavalier students served their community a total of 8,365 hours.

For John Carroll students athletics are an integral part of the student life. 



Affordability and access remain a top priority for John Carroll in accord with our Catholic faith. Approximately 1/3 of our student body population receives financial aid totaling over \$500,000. Now 30 years old, the Bruno Campus is a fitting home for John Carroll's many legacies. It is essential that it remain an inspiring place for students to learn and grow, and for it to continue to be the hub of community life for our families and for the greater Catholic community in Central Alabama.

Making strategic capital improvements will allow John Carroll to provide our educators with the best learning and teaching environment possible. Currently, yearly expenses for electricity and HVAC maintenance run approximately \$250K and \$100K respectively. Making strategic capital improvements will carry John Carroll confidently into the future with a campus that is more environmentally sustainable and remains an inspiring host for learning.

John Carroll has proven its ability to adapt and evolve and through the Ensuring Excellence Campaign we will be able to support the capital and infrastructure needs that will see our current physical spaces well into the future.
