

PBIS EFFORTS: STUDENTS RECOGNIZED FOR THEIR GOOD CHOICES

- Emerson has a PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention & Support) team in place whose mission is to enhance the school culture and climate by reinforcing positive behavior.
- Emerson has a PBIS matrix that outlines school-wide behavior expectations that need to be upheld by the entire school-community.
- Ranger Bucks and the Ranger Store are a School-wide PBIS support for ALL students, in all school settings. Whole-school token economy systems have been proven to be the most effective PBIS strategy to get buy-in from students and to reinforce positive/desirable behaviors.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- BREAKFAST is available at 8:30AM at the main entrance & should not arrive earlier, as there is no adult supervision
- ARRIVAL is at 8:45AM and those not coming for breakfast should not arrive earlier, as there is no adult supervision
- LABELING water bottles & lunch boxes is helpful
- CHROMEBOOKS should be charged & wiped down at home. We do not have enough outlets for the class.
- AT DISMISSAL, students are to go directly home
- OUR EMERSON PLAYGROUND is not open to students after school unless they are accompanied by a parent/guardian
- ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL CAR LINE: Please pull all the way up to the stop sign. Adults must stay in the vehicle, to keep everyone safe. We will load students on the right side, the curb side. If you need to get out of the car, a parking spot is to be used. Please display the car line pick up signs. The bolder the print, the better. Thank you for following our process.


