

Attendance Reminder

- We have been very relaxed on attendance due to some known technical issues with some of the courses and vendors. We will begin to implement the attendance calculations beginning September 21. Attendance calculations are based upon assignment completion, you must stay on pace or ahead in order to be considered in attendance.
- From your dashboard, take the total number of assignments and divide it by the days of enrollment to figure out how many assignments you must complete. The genius dashboard will also provide you with “recommended pacing” as an option on the left of your screen.
- Elementary= total assignments divided by 90 will give you the daily total. Multiply by 5 for the weekly total and round up if the number is a decimal – ex.20.3 = 21
- MS = total assignments divided by 45 will give you the daily total. Multiply by 5 for the weekly total and round up if the number is a decimal – ex.20.3 = 21
- HS= Since you are on a block schedule you will need to look at each course individually and take the days of enrollment and divide by the total assignments. Add up your results for each course to find your daily total and round up if the number is a decimal– ex.20.3 = 21

In most courses, you will need to complete 1 assignment per day per course in order to stay on pace. Some courses may require a faster pace depending on the assignments and your enrollment period. All work must be completed by the course END DATE.

Assignments Due Weekly

K -13 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
1st – 15 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
2nd – 13 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
3rd – 13 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
4th – 18 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
5th – 20 assignments per week or on pace/ahead
6th-8th – 19 assignments per week or on pace/ahead or 23 with a computer or language
HS – need to look at each course to calculate your total since your schedules are on block
