Hello, I am Lauren Ramirez and the PTO President.


I have four boys who attend BTES and have been a member of the PTO for 6 years (3 years as a general member, 2 years as the Corresponding Secretary, and this year as the President).



Parents/Guardians/Mentors/Teachers are busy, but we all have things in common; we are all here for the KIDS!






# PTO Meeting Minutes: May 12, 2022


#### Call to Order:


- -A Meeting of the Belle Terre Elementary PTO was held in person and via Zoom on Thursday, May 12, 2022.





















