Your student has been referred to our Falcon Academy after school homework help program.

This program is designed to assist students with organizational skills, schoolwork completion, and additional support in all academic subject areas.

Dates: FRMS Academy starts Monday, September 19, 2022 and runs through Thursday, May 25, 2023. These sessions are offered weekly Monday through Thursday.

Time: 3:15pm - 4:50pm

Location: Media Center

Transportation: Students who live in the Falcon Ridge attendance area may ride the activity bus home. Students board buses at 4:55pm. Falcon Academy teachers will help your child determine which bus route to ride and provide an activity bus pass. The pass is required for admission to ride the activity bus. Students who are picked up by a parent or walking home must leave by 5:00pm.

Please consider enrolling your student in the program so they can have the opportunity to work with our trained teachers in order to receive increased academic support.

Arrive in the homework help room by 3:15 pm.

Work on school work or bring a book to read.

If students are not taking the activity bus you may call for a ride when your work is finished.

Tell a teacher when your ride is coming.

Remain in the Media Center until 4:50pm or when your ride arrives.

No computer games or cell phone use in the media center.

Snacks may be provided and students can bring their own snack.
