Extended Lunch

Brooke Moade and Abigail Brown, PHS ASB Co-Presidents, proposed an extended lunch privilege during Advisory (Tuesday - Thursday) to the Admin Team. Through some discussion we were able to find a compromises that worked for everyone.

Advisory period was designed to provide support to students that need to meet with teachers, get additional help in a class or take a test (that had been missed). This has been a beneficial time for many students and a time that many students value, but for those students that have everything turned in and good grades, it has been a good social time and disruptive for those trying to do their work. That is why, this proposal is something that can work for everyone.

Students are eligible for extended lunch if they had a 3.0 GPA Trimester 3 from High School (freshman are not eligible until beginning of Trimester 2 this year). Please note, it is Trimester 3 grades, not their CUM GPA.

Every student that meets this requirement will be dismissed from advisory at 11:55 am, unless one of the following apply:

- Have a D or F in Wazzle on Monday morning when grades are pulled by administration.
- The student received a referral from a teacher or administration throughout the prior week.

Each advisory teacher has a list of students that have been approved for the Extended Lunch, and will receive information each Monday on those student's that have lost this privilege. These lists will be reestablished at the beginning of Trimester 2, based on Trimester 1 grades; freshman will then be eligible for this privilege.
