Cell Phone Policy

Please be aware that the following school policy relating to the use of cellular phones on school campus is currently in effect (for complete policy, please see Ed Code 48901.5). This policy also applies to the Child Care programs and is supplemented by the condition that a violation of the student use of cell phones during the operation hours of school will result in the confiscation of the student's phone.

1. Cell phones are permitted for emergency use only and must be used with adult supervision. Students may not call or text home during the school day from a cell phone.
2. Cell phones must be kept in a backpack and turned off at all times throughout the school day. This also includes any school sponsored before/after school programs and activities.
3. Use of a cell phone camera is strictly prohibited on school grounds.
4. If your child is found breaking any of the rules mentioned above, the following steps will be taken:

First offense – Parent/Guardian will be notified by phone; referral given to student; student may pick up cell phone at the end of the school day.

Second offense and thereafter- Cell phone must be picked up by parent.

Students who continually violate our policy must leave their cell phones in the office.

If you bring a phone/electronic devices to school it is at your own risk.
The school is not responsible for any loss or damage to a phone.
