FALL

- Finalize Your College List:** Use tools like [Big Future](#) and college websites to assist you. The general rule is select no more than 3-4 colleges. Make sure you have a balanced list of an academic safety, fit, and reach schools.

- Letters of Recommendation:** Most colleges do not require them. If required, go to our [Counseling Center webpage](#), fill-out/turn-in the needed “letter of recommendation form” and give your recommender at least 3 wks to complete.

- Request an Official Transcript** to be sent to each college you apply to by going to [East High’s website](#), click on Students, [Student Records](#), and then follow the instructions. You don’t need to request transcripts for schools on the [Common App](#) (e.g., UofU). Transcripts are sent to Common App schools when counselors do their part.
- Get help Researching and Applying for Scholarships:** through AVID, GEARUP, College Access Advisor, and our Scholarship Advisor; and by going to free websites like [fastweb.com](#), [USHE State Scholarships](#), [Keys To Success](#), etc.

- Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE):** possible out-of-state tuition reduction within the western region.
- To play NCAA Division I or II college sports** you must meet their minimum [academic requirements](#) and apply through their [Eligibility Center](#).

SPRING

- Consider Visiting Colleges** you’ve been accepted to determine your best fit. You will be notified of admission acceptance typically by email or the college’s own application portal, and then later by mail.
- Accept Admission by the Deadline:** Each college will have a deadline for students to make a final admission decision. They may require you to pay a registration deposit at that time.
- Setup and regularly check your college email account** because that is how they will communicate with you after you accept their admissions offer.
- Sign up for Freshmen Orientation** at your college as soon as possible (typically in the early summer).
- Request your Final Transcript** to be sent to the college you will attend before you graduate by going to [East High’s website](#), click on Students, [Student Records](#), and then follow the instructions. If you are going to a Common App school let your counselor know what school he/she should submit your final transcript to.
- Attend East High’s Decision Day Activities** typically in May and celebrate your bright futures together!
