

Good evening Falcon Families,

This is Dr. Nehrig with an important update. To help us continue to improve our traffic flow during arrival time, we are making an adjustment to our student entrance procedures. Beginning tomorrow, our morning student entrance procedures will be as follows:

- ALL students dropped off by vehicle in the car loop & walkers who come from the north (Taylor Road) on Blue Lake will enter campus via the middle doors (breezeway) in the center of the 400 building. Car loop supervision and Safety Patrols will direct students to that doorway.
- Bus riders and walkers who come from the south (Orange Camp) on Blue Lake will enter campus via the gate closest to the front office.
- Parents who bring your students by vehicle, please remain in your vehicles to drop off your students. Parents will not be permitted to walk students to the gate by the front office or the doorway in the middle of the 400 building. There are very few exceptions to this, based on student enrollment in our Pre-K program or special education program. Please see administration if you have any questions.
- As always, we ask parent drivers to pull all the way forward as far as possible before dropping students off. This prevents backups, which cost time to everyone else behind you in the line.

By continuing to work together, we will both keep our students safe and reduce the time it takes to make it through traffic.
