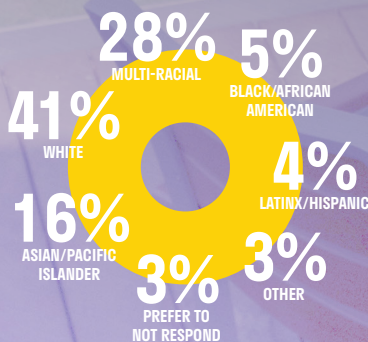

HONORS RESEARCH PROGRAM (HUMANITIES, SCIENCE, SOCIAL SCIENCES)

Students pursue independent research in collaboration with a professional in the greater Los Angeles area. Students engage in cutting-edge research while designing and implementing an original research project that culminates with a research paper and campus-wide presentation.

SPECIAL STUDIES

Students who have challenged themselves in all aspects of a department's course offerings can continue their study beyond the standard curriculum through Special Studies.

HONORS CAPSTONE PROGRAM (ARTS, SOCIAL JUSTICE, ENTREPRENEURSHIP)

Taken in lieu of a fifth academic course (given the time commitment required), students choose a field of interest and deepen their knowledge of that area through research and hands-on experience, identify a specific problem or question within the field, propose a solution, and attempt to implement a solution in the form of a project or practicum.
