Purchase at any Ferndale school or district office

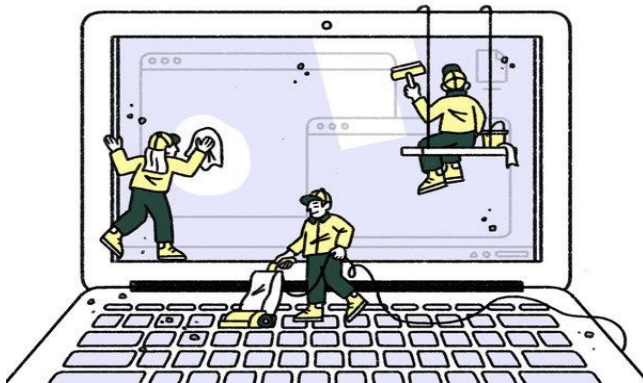
Ferndale School District is offering device insurance policy for \$25/year as part of the school's technology program.

*\$10 for student who qualifies for free/reduced lunch (bring the food service free/reduced approval letter to office when paying)

Accidental insurance policy covers:

- ✓ Accidental Damage (Drops & Spills)
- ✓ Cracked screen
- ✓ Liquid submersion
- ✓ Fire, Flood & Natural Disaster
- ✓ Power Surge by Lightning

Does not cover intentional damages or unexplained loss
