Overview

The ideal candidate is an enthusiastic educator who has experience teaching elementary age students. The candidate seeks professional growth and learning every day and inspires others to do the same through optimism, selflessness, flexibility, and teamwork. The candidate possesses a willingness to collaborate with dedicated educators within the Sacred Heart faculty and a passion for all-girls education. The candidate will show empathy for and a passion to work with young children as well as a commitment to the development of the whole child.

Sacred Heart Academy Bryn Mawr works to create a community and curriculum that reflect our values of diversity, equity, inclusion, and justice and the candidate should model these values.

Major Responsibilities and Key Duties

- Develops and implements grade-appropriate lesson plans, activities, and assessments to meet the academic, developmental, and social needs of students
- Supports the social-emotional needs of children, guided by the use of trauma-informed practices
- Monitors and guides classroom behavior in accordance with the Sacred Heart Goals & Criteria
- Evaluates and monitors student's performance and progress
- Assesses students' academic and social progress and makes recommendations for interventions and evaluations when necessary
- Incorporates place-based education and project-based learning into the curriculum whenever possible
- Facilitates curriculum and programming to assist students in social, emotional, and behavioral growth
- Develops and maintains a relationship with each child that ensures the child knows they are cared for and valued
- Collaborates with colleagues and administrators to ensure that each child's experience at the school reflects a coordinated plan to maximize the opportunities for personal and educational growth
- Develops and maintains positive partnerships with families as an important aspect of ensuring personal and educational growth



- Commits to ongoing professional development and growth, continually learning and developing enhanced pedagogical and counseling skills
- Willingness to work with colleagues to evaluate, design, and implement curricula
- Commitment to curriculum and instruction that demonstrates cultural competency

Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education or a related field
- Master's degree in Education, preferred but not required
- Minimum of 2 years of teaching experience, strongly preferred
- Experience with Fundations or some other early reading program, strongly preferred
