Prior to Test Day

On Test Day

Eat a good breakfast

Minimize distractions and create a quiet testing environment

Join the class on Zoom/TEAMs on time or a little early. If you are testing on an iPad, you must join class from a second device (phone).

Open the app (iPad) or testing window (laptop) and wait for the session name/password.

Double check that you can text with the teacher and follow the teacher's directions.

Remember the MAP testing mantra:

"Take a breath, read the question, take your best guess, move on"

During the mathematics test, have pencil and paper nearby.
