

Campbell City Schools Board of Education Minutes  
Special Meeting – Thursday, September 1, 2022

A special meeting of the Campbell City Schools’ Board of Education was held at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Education Conference Room. President Gary Bednarik presided and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The following members were present to roll call:

**I. Motion to accept the Special Meeting Notice**

**II. RESOLUTION #2022-72:**

It is recommended by the superintendent to the Board of Education that it approve the following:

**A. WHEREAS**, the Campbell City School District Board of Education (“Board of Education”) anticipates that the District may experience difficulty obtaining substitute teachers during the 2022-2023 school year; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to authority granted in Section 4 of Senate Bill 1, which was enacted by the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly and became effective as an emergency measure on October 28, 2021, the Board of Education was authorized to establish its own education requirements for individuals to serve as substitute teachers in the District during the 2021-2022 school year; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly has extended this authority for the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years through enactment of House Bill 583; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education desires to temporarily adopt modified education requirements for substitute teachers in accordance with the law during the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years as a measure to help ensure availability of a sufficient number of substitute teachers.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Campbell City School District Board of Education as follows:

**SECTION I**

The Board of Education temporarily authorizes the employment of substitute teachers who do not hold post-secondary degrees, as is otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3319.226 and 3319.30, Ohio Administrative Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy 3120.04 - Employment of Substitutes, during the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years. In addition to fulfilling the educational requirements adopted by the Board of Education, an individual must be of good moral character and must have completed

all required criminal background checks, as well as obtained a valid non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education to serve as a substitute teacher in the District.

**SECTION II**

It is found and determined that all formal action of this Board concerning or related to the adoption of this Resolution was adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were adopted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all applicable requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.

It is recommended by the superintendent to the Board of Education that it approve the following:

- A. A purchase service from Curriculum Associates for i-Ready Assessment and Personal Instruction Math and Reading Site License, Math per student license and reading per student license for a period of one (1) year in the amount of \$28,158.00 made payable through Title I and/or ESSER Funds.

**IV. RESOLUTION #2022-74:**

It is recommended by the superintendent to the Board of Education that it approve the following:

- A. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and MedStar EMS & Transportation, INC. to provide one (1) staffed ambulance at six (6) football games during the 2022 season at a cost of \$2,100.00. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
- B. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and The Mahoning County Board of Developmental Disabilities for payment of attendant services for two (2) students as per the IEP for the 2022-2023 school year. The cost per attendant will be \$16.15 per hour, Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. following the school calendar. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
- C. An agreement between the Mahoning County Council of Government and Campbell City Schools to purchase services for the following positions:
  - One (1) Educational Assistant/Personal Attendant for up to twenty (20) hours per week for the 2022-2023 school year.
- D. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and Mahoning County High School for services provided at a cost of \$97 per student day commencing July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office)

- E. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and R.E.M. Counseling Associates to provide for local evaluation services and additional assistance to Campbell City Schools' 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center Grant for the period September 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$9,900.00. Funds made payable through grant proceeds. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
- F. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and R.E.M. Counseling Associates to provide for local evaluation services and additional assistance to Campbell Memorial High Schools' School Quality Improvement Grant (SQIG) for the period September 1, 2022 through July 15, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. Funds made payable through grant proceeds. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
- G. An agreement between Campbell City Schools and R.E.M. Counseling Associates to provide for local evaluation services and additional assistance to Campbell Elementary & Middle Schools' School Quality Improvement Grant (SQIG) for the period September 1, 2022 through July 15, 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. Funds made payable through grant proceeds. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
- H. To grant permission through an Audio/Video Transmission Partnership Agreement between Campbell City Schools and The Yokley Scott Corporation, LLC (YSN) to be the official media partner and to transmit, via the Internet, the complete live video and audio of select events effective August 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025, where the district will receive \$100.00 per season from YSN. (A copy of this agreement is on file in the Treasurer's Office.)
