North Andover is bordered by the towns of Andover, North Reading, Boxford and Middleton and the cities of Methuen, Haverhill and Lawrence. Curriculum Overview

North Andover High School operates on a semester schedule and offers a curriculum that includes both weighted and unweighted courses. Students receive a weighted grade point average based on a 4.0 scale that includes all courses completed in the five core academic areas (English, World Language, History, Math, and Science). North Andover High School does not calculate class rank.

Graduation Requirements

North Andover High School calculates grade point average using the same method that the Massachusetts State Colleges use in their admissions process. Students earn 5 credits for every full year course and 2.5 credits for each semester class on their schedule.

NEW SCHEDULE STATEMENT

North Andover High School moved from a trimester schedule to a semester schedule for the 2021-22 school year. Most core classes are year long, 5 credit classes. Some additional core classes and most electives are semester long, 2.5 credit classes. Final grades will be available on a student's transcript at the end of the semester for 2.5 credit classes and at the end of the school year for 5 credit classes.

COVID-19 STATEMENT

NAHS moved to a fully remote teaching and learning model on March 13, 2020. As a result, the grading policy changed to a Pass/No Credit system for trimester 3 of that year. These grades do not impact a student's GPA. Students did not have the opportunity to participate in athletics or co-curricular activities from March-June 2020.

Graduation requirements remained the same for the 20-21 school year but course offerings changed due to students having the choice between a hybrid or a fully remote teaching and learning model. Counselors will expound further in cases where specific students were heavily impacted.
