


# Instructional Program Review



The purpose of the instructional program review and assessment is to provide a system for continuous improvement in instructional programs. Review and assessment procedures provide recognition of the accomplishments of an instructional program as well as identify interventions needed for improvement of the program.

Each instructional program will be evaluated once in each five year period. An Instructional Program Review meeting will be held to provide a review committee an opportunity to discuss the documents, ask questions of the appropriate instructional program coordinators, and make any recommendations to the Instructional Affairs Council for the improvement of the instructional programs. Programs are reviewed by major functional areas and/or locations whenever possible. Instructional programs that are offered on multiple campuses, or through distance learning, will be assessed as a single unit.
