What is your child learning?

STEM

> Math: Students are finishing Unit 1: Place Value and Decimal Computation. Students will add and subtract decimals, multiply and divide by powers of ten, and solve metric measurement conversions.

> Unit 2 will be multiplication of whole numbers. Please continue reviewing multiplication facts at home with your child.

> Science: We will continue our “Earth Systems” unit in which students will learn about the various spheres of earth including the geosphere, biosphere, hydrosphere, and atmosphere.

Humanities

> Reading: Students are moving into the genre of folktales and poetry as we continue to focus on the comprehension skill of determining theme. In addition, students will be preparing for the reading portion of the Comprehension Benchmark Assessment. (CBA)

> Writing: Students are responding to texts in reading in order to express and expand their thinking by using text details. In addition, students will be preparing for the written portion of the fall CBA.
