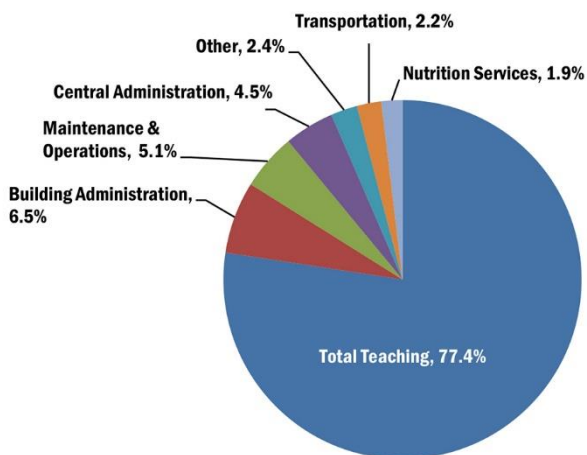
2020-21 School Goals

Teacher leadership met to analyze data and set goals. Grade-level teams meet monthly to assess progress.

- Grades K-2 Reading: 90% of kindergarten, 92% of 1st grade and 95% of 2nd grade students at benchmark on end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 93% of 3rd grade, 92% of 4th grade, and 89% of 5th grade students will score at/near grade level as measured by the Smarter Balanced ELA Assessment
- Grades 3-5 Math: 90% of 3rd grade, 91% of 4th grade, and 84% of 5th grade students will score at/near grade level as measured by the Smarter Balanced Math Assessment
- Grade 5 Science: 87% at standard
- Achievement gap: 70% of ELL students in grades 3-5 at standard
- School Effectiveness: 80% of teachers will Agree Completely or Agree Mostly that "School leadership cares about me"
- Attendance: 7% of student absences will be considered "unexcused" absences as recorded by the registrar in Skyward by the end of the 2018-2019 school year.
- Discipline: Utilizing the PUMAS school-wide positive behavior intervention structure, office referrals will decrease to fewer than 60.

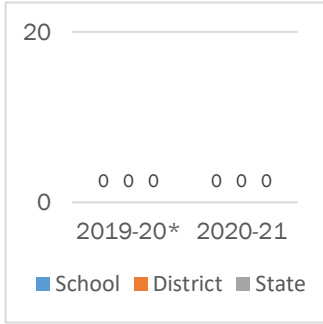

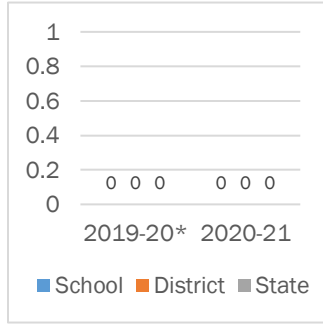

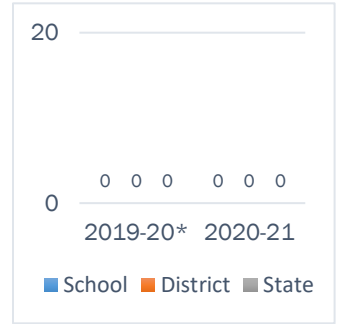
3rd Grade English Language Arts



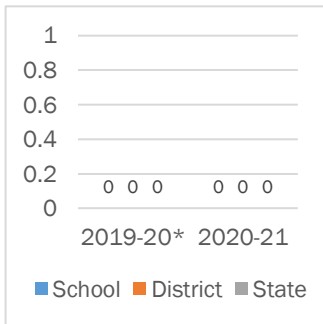
4th Grade English Language Arts



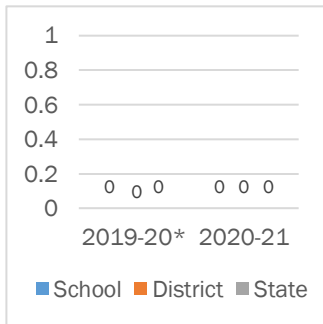
5th Grade English Language Arts



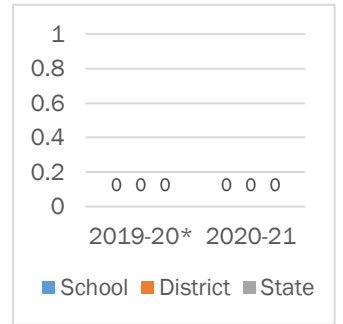
3rd Grade Math



4th Grade Math

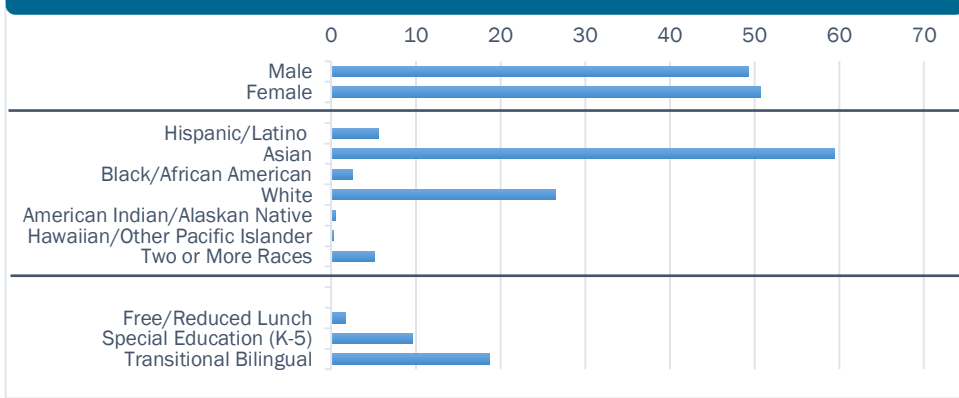


5th Grade Math
