Our school has high academic and behavioral standards. The school encourages parents and community members to assist students in developing skills to become independent and self-sufficient adults.

The rich, classical learning environment is based on historical themes with an emphasis on mastery learning for all students. By integrating as many subjects as possible into year-long historical themes, students learn from the past to make better choices and decisions in the future. Students have the same teacher for most of the school day. That enhances opportunities for integration of subject matter, increases continuity and the students' sense of belonging during early adolescence.

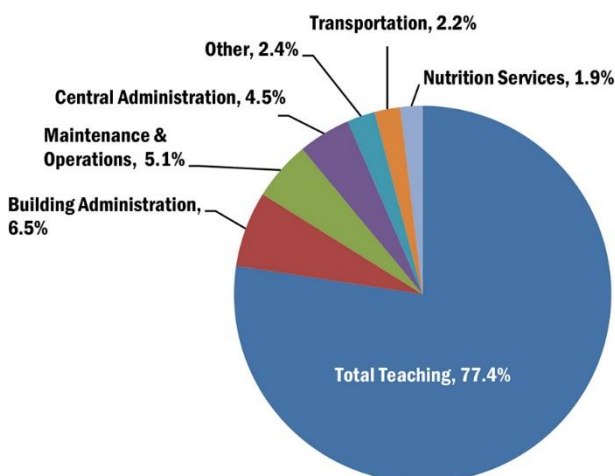

- Attendance/ Discipline: We have very few attendance/discipline problems at Stella Schola Middle School.

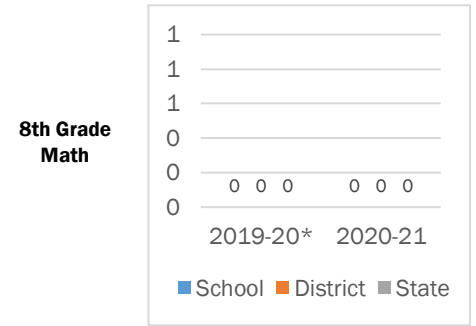
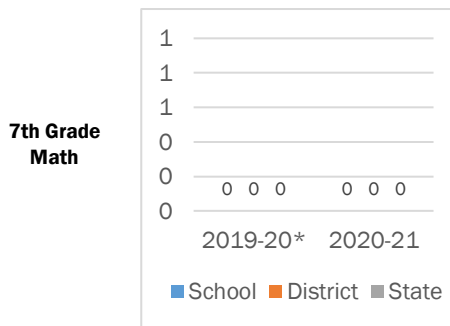
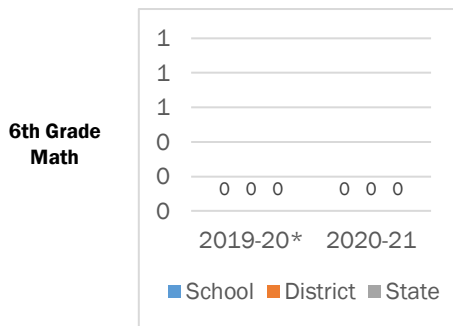
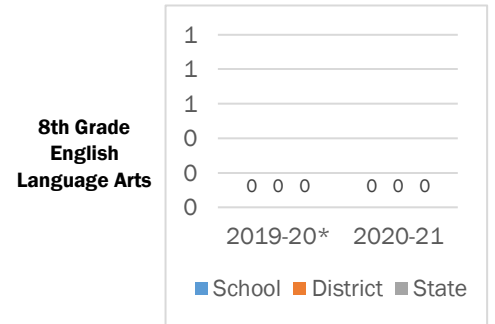
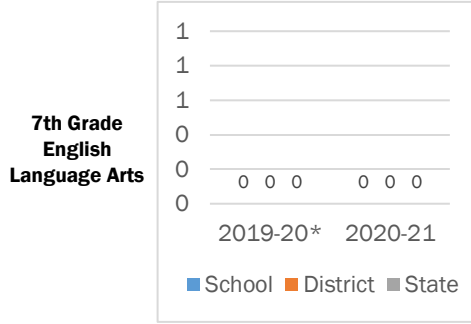
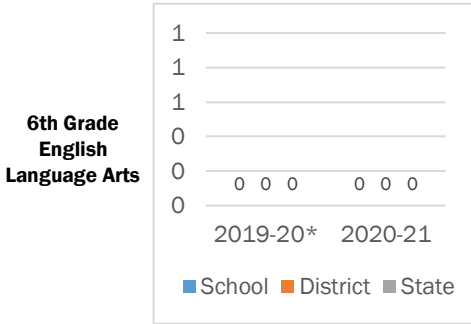
2020-21 District Expenditures

Where does the money go?



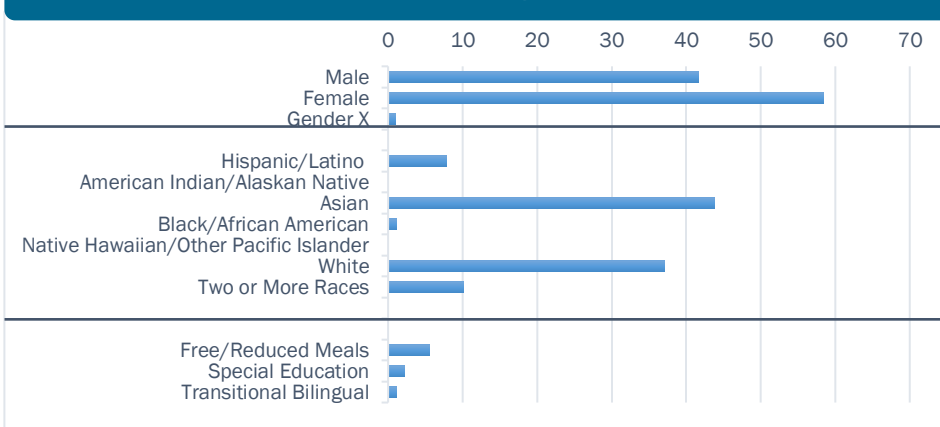
State Assessment Results
