Reminders from the Front Office Staff

Tardy, Early checkout, Late pickup, and Absences:

Tardy: If you drop your student off after 8:10am, the student needs to go through the front office, wait in the front office until they have filled out a tardy slip. They can then go to their classroom.

On average, we have between 40-50 students tardy daily.

If you **check your student out early**, please go to the front office where front office staff will call your student for you from their classroom. You will need to sign your student out and put the reason down for the early checkout.

Early checkout during your student's lunchtime will no longer be available. Please make note of the schedule below to make appropriate plans. The front office is with limited staff during this time.

Late pick-ups: If your student is picked up more than 10 minutes late, they will be marked as late pick up. **Every Tuesday for the year is an adjusted day, 1:30pm pickup time.**

Independent Study

If your student will be missing school for a minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 10 days you can request an independent study. The form is located in the front office. The form needs to be filled out no later than 3 days before the absence. The teacher can accept or decline the independent study. If the teacher accepts, work will be assigned for the student to complete, while absent. **The work needs to be returned to the teacher on the student’s first day back. If the work is not returned then the absence is a non-excused absence.**
