

6-12 Student Google Apps Fact Sheet for Teachers

Here's what you need to know about your students' accounts for Google Apps for Education.

- Every student in the District has been given an account in Google Apps for Education except for those whose parents have opted them out
- Parents have the right to opt their student out of Google Apps for Education in two ways:
 - They can opt out completely, meaning their student will have no access to Google Apps for Education
 - They can opt out of email only while still allowing access to other Google Apps for Education resources such as Google Docs and individual log ins for Chromebooks
- Student accounts look like this: zb5555@pleasantonusd.net where the letters are the student's initials, and the digits are a randomly assigned four digit number. We are using this instead of the student's ID number to help protect the student's identity.
- Students can and should log into Chromebooks on your campus using their own Google Apps for Education account
- Student passwords need to be activated by the student. A separate handout that describes that process is viewable here: <http://go.pleasantonusd.net/vejqq>
