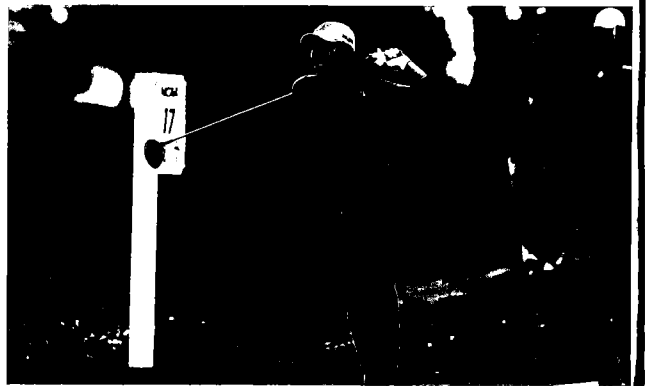
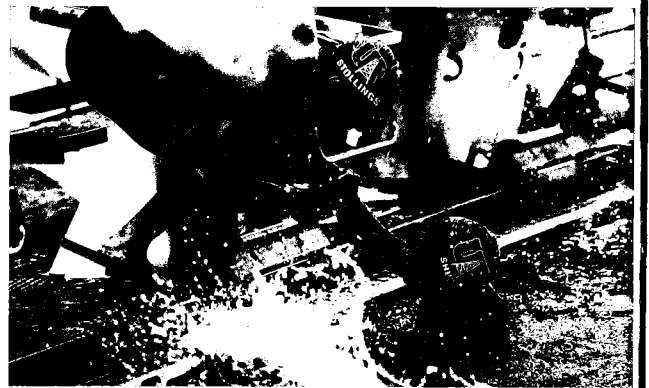

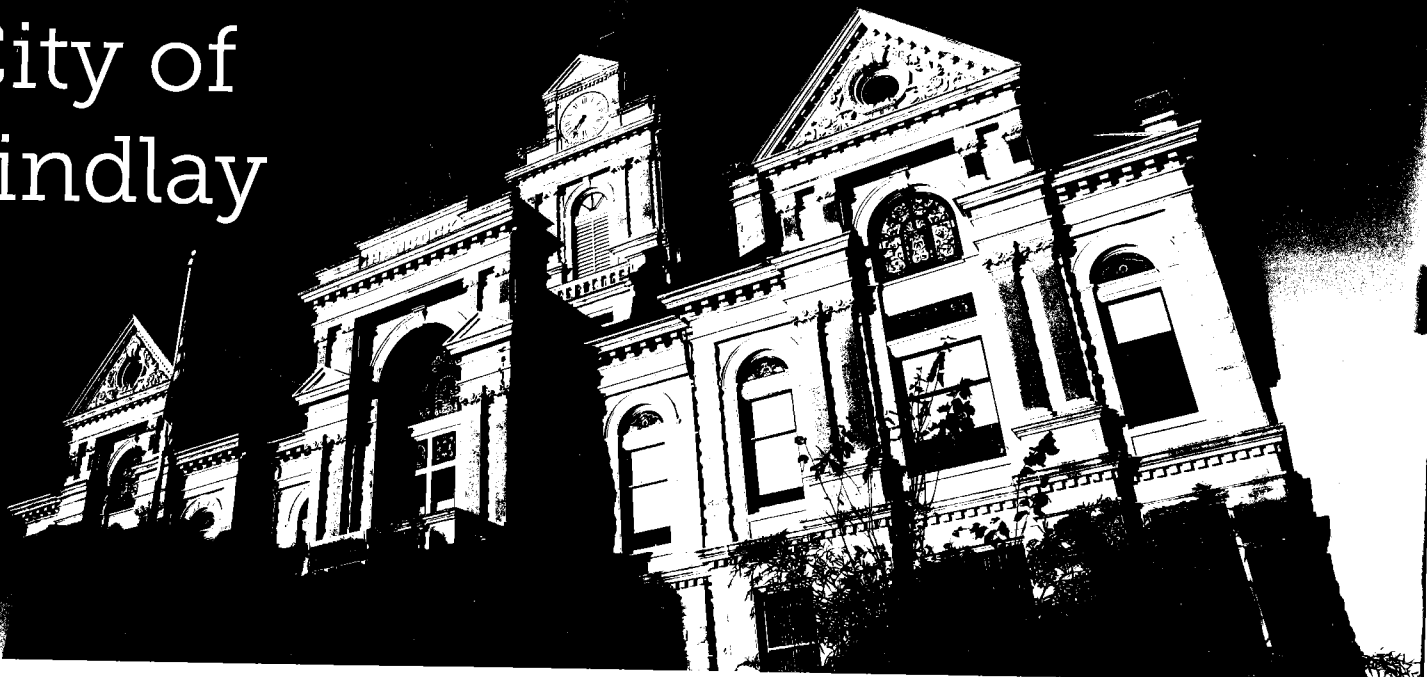

Located approximately 40 miles south of Toledo and one-and-a-half hours from Columbus, Dayton, and Detroit, Findlay is known as a cooperative and innovative community. 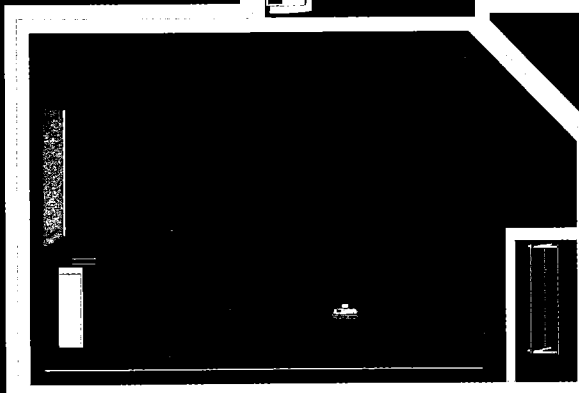
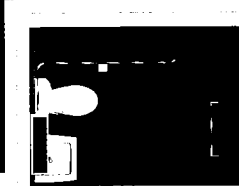
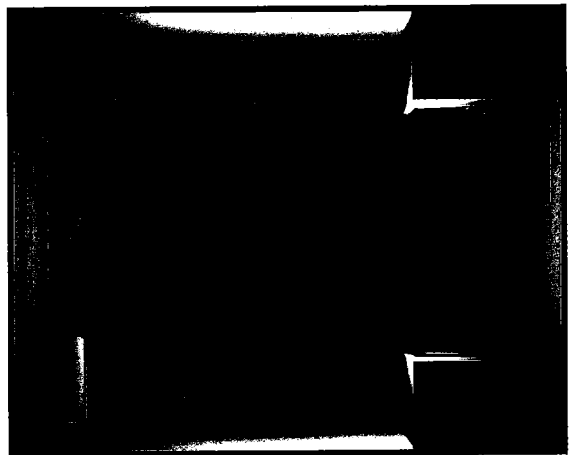
### Bare & Fox Halls
