- a. Secretary's Report

- b. Treasurer's Report

- i. JoAnn presented report, balance of \$22,074.87 in checking account; \$6,249.94 in the SAE Loan account.
- ii. Raised \$1095 with Suffield on the Green
- iii. \$490 from apparel at Welcome back Picnic
 - 1. Ken made motion to accept the report, Tony seconded; report was accepted

c. Membership

- i. Ken attended a state meeting in Woodbury and received clarification on alumni annual members
 - 1. Tom DeMarco walked group the system on how to access membership and fees
 - 2. Different grants available, Give Back to Your Roots (up to \$5,000); Legacy Improving Scholarship (\$500), Legacy Alumni Scholarship (\$1,000); September 1; then March & June 1st
 - 3. 3rd week in June 2023, International FFA trip to Spain & Portugal next year
 - 4. Woodbury has a parent/alumni volunteer form
 - 5. Suffield is the only chapter that doesn't charge for friends, family, and alumni annual membership (~\$25).
