This RFI is a collaboration between Wayne RESA and our Wayne County school districts. As a collaborative consortium, we do not have a specific existing scenario on which to base a BIA. Therefore, there is no Business Impact Analysis available.</p>

Any solution that you put forth to utilize that space in such a way would be considered.</p>
