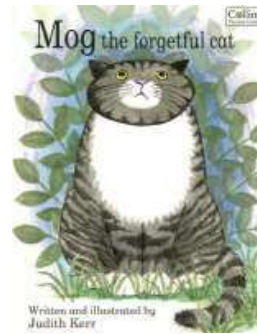


If you have a pet, draw your pet and label their body using adjectives (describing words). Brown eyes, sharp claws, soft fur, for example.
