SCHOOLS

The public school system enrolls approximately 5,300 students in an all-day kindergarten center, four elementary schools, an intermediate school, a middle school and a four-year high school. Austin High School is an architectural historical site and was given the Preservation Alliance of Minnesota Award in 1996. Advanced Placement courses are offered in Computer Science Principles, Calculus, Statistics and Functions, Biology, Physics, US History, Human Geography and Spanish Language/Culture. The Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Program in Minnesota makes it possible for high school students to receive credit in Minnesota colleges, universities, and technical colleges as part of their high school program. Riverland Community College classes that are offered at Austin High School include Humanities, Composition, Speech, American Government, Microeconomics, US History, College Algebra, Pre-Calculus and Welding. Austin High School operates an Area Learning Center as well as an Austin Online Academy for students grades 9-12.
