Welcome to the Dallas County Promise Path form!

Congratulations on starting your journey to your future career! Your path to success can take many different directions - along with your high school support staff and our higher education partners, the Dallas County Promise team is here to help you find your best fit post-high school pathway. Our goal is simple: to support you in pursuing your best fit college and career option after high school.

The Promise Path form is the first step to be eligible for the Dallas County Promise scholarship program, but that's not all! Completing the form also gets you access to support and resources from the Dallas County Promise team. The Promise Path form must be submitted no later than February 1, 2023.

The Dallas County Promise last-dollar scholarship covers your cost of classes (tuition) after other grants and scholarships are applied, and connects you with dedicated support staff to help you navigate and succeed in your college experience. The scholarship does not cover any other costs such as room and board, books/supplies, meals, transportation, etc.

Students who complete their Promise Path form by February 1, 2023 have until March 1, 2023 to (1) submit a Fall 2023 admission application to a Dallas County Promise partner college through GoApplyTexas.org and (2) submit the 2023-2024 FAFSA or TASFA and list the Dallas County Promise partner college(s) you are considering. The deadline for Promise-bound students to register for Fall 2023 classes is July 26, 2023. Please note that some Dallas County Promise partner college have earlier deadlines. Students must submit their applications by the deadlines for each Promise Partner college of interest, and then be fully admitted to meet eligibility. Promise Path Information & Getting Started

Promise Path Information

- 1. Dallas County 2023 graduates attending participating high schools complete their Promise Path form by February 1. Graduating high school seniors who do not complete their Promise Path form by February 1 will not be eligible for the Dallas County Promise Scholarship. Additionally, students must attend a participating high school for their full senior year and qualify for in-state tuition.
- 2. The Dallas County Promise Path form is **non-binding**. Students completing the Promise Path form are **not committing** to attend a Promise Partner college. You may not be 100% sure where you want to attend college at this time that is ok, we know your path changes! Complete your Promise Path form to ensure you have the option of having your tuition covered by a Promise Partner college, and then choose the post-high school path that is best for you.
- 3. This is a student form for graduating seniors at participating high schools. Please do not use your parent/legal guardian's name in the student information for your Promise Path form. Each Promise Path form will require an unique, personal (not school issued) student email address. If you are a parent or guardian supporting two or more graduating seniors, each student must submit their own Promise Path form using a different e-mail address.
- 4. Complete the Promise Path form and confirm submission at the end of the form. If you do not click Review and Confirm on the final page, you have not completed the Promise Path form. You will receive a confirmation email within 24 hours of form submission. Please contact Student.Success@dallascountypromise.org if you have questions or do not receive a confirmation email.



You'll receive a welcome email from the Dallas County Promise team with your Promise ID - you don't need to memorize this number, but keep it for your records since it is your unique ID in the Dallas County Promise information system.

By March 1, 2023*:

- Complete a Fall 2023 admissions application for the Promise Partner Colleges you're considering at GoApplyTexas.org or at the partner college's website.
- Submit the 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.gov and list the college(s) you are interested in.

Students that qualify for in-state tuition who are non-citizens or have DACA/Dreamer status should submit the 2023-2024 Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) through the new online TASFA form (opening October 1, 2023) OR print a paper version from College for All Texans and submit directly to the college's financial aid departments.

By July 26, 2023:

· Register for Fall 2023 classes at a Promise Partner College.

*Students considering SMU, UNT (Denton), MSU, TAMU-Texarkana or UTA need to complete all application steps by deadlines different than the ones above. Please see DallasCountyPromise.org for more details. Additionally, SMU applicants must complete a Mustang Scholars essay and CSS Profile.
