- Richard Scholfield, a Scottish saxophonist whose music weaves together tradition and innovation and who has previously performed in Mayfield at the Concert of All The Talents in 2021;
- **Tabea Streicher**, a German pianist who holds a scholarship at the International Music Academy in Liechtenstein; and
- Adele Theveneau, a French cellist who studied at the National Conservatory in Paris.
