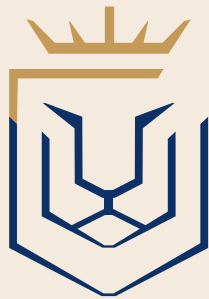

Nobel British International School Algarve is proud to announce its Extracurricular Activities Programme that includes many activities from which your child/children can choose, and also an extended timetable. We know how important it is that students grow beyond the classroom and we hope this helps students develop or discover their passion! The programme will start in October 2022 and will finish in June 2023.

Goals:

Our main goals are to promote and organise enjoyable activities for all students, which will have educational, cultural, sports and fun purposes.

Nobel Algarve is also concerned with its families' busy lives and thought about activities that can extend their child/children's school day, making it easier for parents to consolidate their working day with their family life.

Schedule:

The activities will run daily from Monday to Friday, at two different times:

- the first, from 1:00 pm to 1:55 pm;
- the second, from 4:35 pm to 5:30 pm.

Your child/children may choose to participate in one or both time slots.

Enrolment:

Enrolments start now and you may do so at any time of the year that best suits you.

To sign up, you will need to fill in the enrolment document below giving permission for your child/children to take part in a specific activity.

Each activity will need a minimum number of children (according to each activity) and/or vacancy.

This may be done either by emailing afterschool.programme@nobelalgarve.com or by obtaining an enrolment form directly from the teacher responsible for each activity.

Safety:

At 1:00 pm or at 4:35 pm, all the students enrolled must go to the room where the activity will take place. However, Pre-school and Year 1 children will be taken by their activity teacher.

For safety reasons, at the end of the afternoon activities (5:30pm), each student must be collected either by their parents or by someone that has been authorised. The activity teacher must be notified in advance of any changes to this arrangement.

Material / Gear:

Specific items for the activity will be suggested by the teacher and each child will be expected to bring their own.

Snack:

Your child/children should always bring a snack and drink for the activity as this will not be provided by the school.

Rate:

- 50€ monthly cost per activity twice a week;
- 25€ monthly cost per activity once a week.

Payments should go to the front office along with the form in an envelope marked Extracurricular.

If payment does not take place during the two following months, your child/children's enrolment will be cancelled and he/she may not be permitted to enrol again.
