Our Shoe Collection Drive will run through March 3rd. Our community, with the support of our sister San Juan Campuses at American River and Carmichael, have collected 506 pairs of gently used or new shoes. All donated shoes will then be redistributed throughout the Funds2Orgs network of microenterprise partners in developing nations. Funds2Orgs helps impoverished people start, maintain and grow businesses in countries such as Haiti, Honduras and other nations in Central America and Africa.		
On Saturday, February 6 th CMP Orangevale hosted an E-Waste fundraiser in partnership with Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps (SRCC). SRCC is a CA State approved Collector of Electronic Waste. SRCC takes the E-waste to California Electronic Asset Recovery (CEAR) a CA State approved Recycler of Electronic Waste. CMP Orangevale will earn \$0.03 per pound for eligible E-Waste donated by our community.
