

PUBLIC COMMENT at GOVERNING BOARD MEETINGS

If you are interested in making a live public comment at a CMP Board Meeting you may do so in one of the following ways:

- Attend and make live public comment from the Governing Board Meeting in the Gibbons Room of the Carmichael Campus.
- Attend the meeting at one of the remote locations through Zoom and make a public comment via Zoom.
- Attend the meeting at an alternate location and make a public comment via Zoom. An alternate location is any location you are choosing to join from whether that is your own home, your car, your child's soccer game, etc.

If attending the meeting in person, or from one of the remote locations (one of the school sites), please fill out the [Speaker Card](#) and hand it to your campus representative, or Board Secretary. If you wish to submit a public comment on more than one agenda item, please submit a separate form for each item on which you are commenting.

If attending from an alternate location, please use the [CMP Governing Board Electronic Comment Card](#). If you wish to submit a public comment on more than one agenda item, please submit a separate form for each item on which you are commenting.

An electronic comment card has been linked above, in the Board Agenda, and can be found on the Governing Board page of the CMP Website.

Speaker cards may be submitted up until an item has a motion made on it. Speakers will be called by the Governing Board Secretary by agenda item. These presentations are limited to three (3) minutes each.
