

Linking articles from EBSCO, GALE, ProQuest, and CREDO into Blackboard

Linking articles within Blackboard allows faculty to directly share articles with students.

To link articles from EBSCO into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Permalink” from the right-hand side of the screen. The “Permalink” URL will appear at the top of the screen. Copy this link. In Blackboard, click on the plus (+) symbol below “Course Content” and choose “Create.” Then click on “Link.” Paste the URL into the box below “Link URL.” Click “Save.”

To link articles from GALE into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Get Link” from the top right-hand side of the screen. This will generate a link that you can copy and paste. Copy this link. In Blackboard, click on the plus (+) symbol below “Course Content” and choose “Create.” Then click on “Link.” Paste the URL into the box below “Link URL.” Click “Save.”

To link articles from ProQuest into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Click on “Abstract/Details” on left-hand side of page. Scroll down to find the “Document URL.” Copy this link. In Blackboard, click on the plus (+) symbol below “Course Content” and choose “Create.” Then click on “Link.” Paste the URL into the box below “Link URL.” Click “Save.”

To link articles from CREDO Reference into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Page Link” at the top of the screen. Copy this link. In Blackboard, click on the plus (+) symbol below “Course Content” and choose “Create.” Then click on “Link.” Paste the URL into the box below “Link URL.” Click “Save.”

****Keep in mind that students may be prompted to enter their “256” library barcode number in order to gain access to the articles you have posted.**
