Bradfield Science Competition

On Thursday four Year 5 children travelled to Bradfield College for the annual Prep Schools' Science Challenge. They were treated to an afternoon of activities spanning Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

Hannah, Sophie, Arthavit and Barnaby

worked brilliantly as a team and created their own speaker using wire and paper, which successfully played 'Bad Habits' by Ed Sheeran across the lab! They added Sodium Hydrogen Carbonate to Citric Acid in the Chemistry lab and recorded temperature changes, drawing a really challenging but impressive line graph! Finally, the children studied maggots in a choice chamber to see whether they preferred dark or light conditions, and used microscopes to study different types of leaves and consider the weather conditions the plants came from. After a fantastic afternoon of activities, the children were treated to an exciting Science show, complete with wine turning into water, elephant's toothpaste, and exploding balloons!

Hannah, Sophie, Arthavit and Barnaby were a credit to Yateley Manor, their behaviour was impeccable and they demonstrated teamwork, resilience and a passion for Science. We now await the full results from Bradfield, to find out where we placed amongst the other 23 schools.
