Q 5 Although Covid limited visitation this year, parents/guardians generally feel welcome at my child's school.

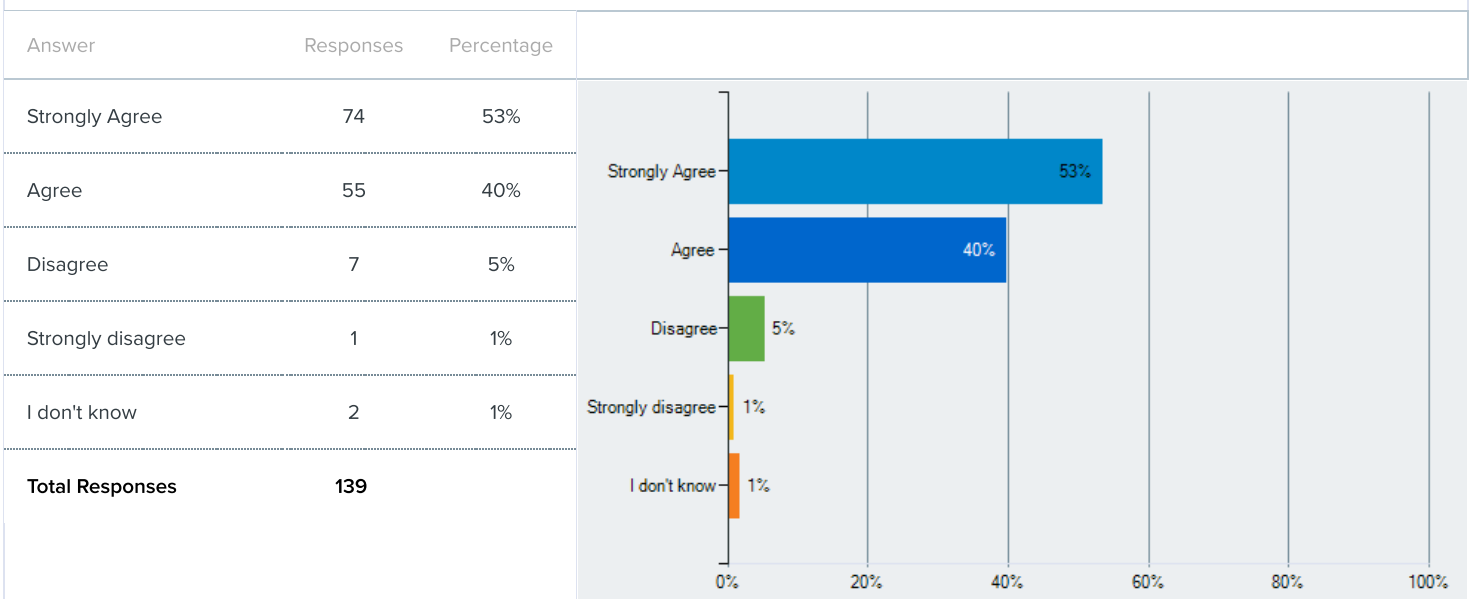


Q 6 There is a mutual sense of respect and cooperation between/among faculty/staff and parents at this school.

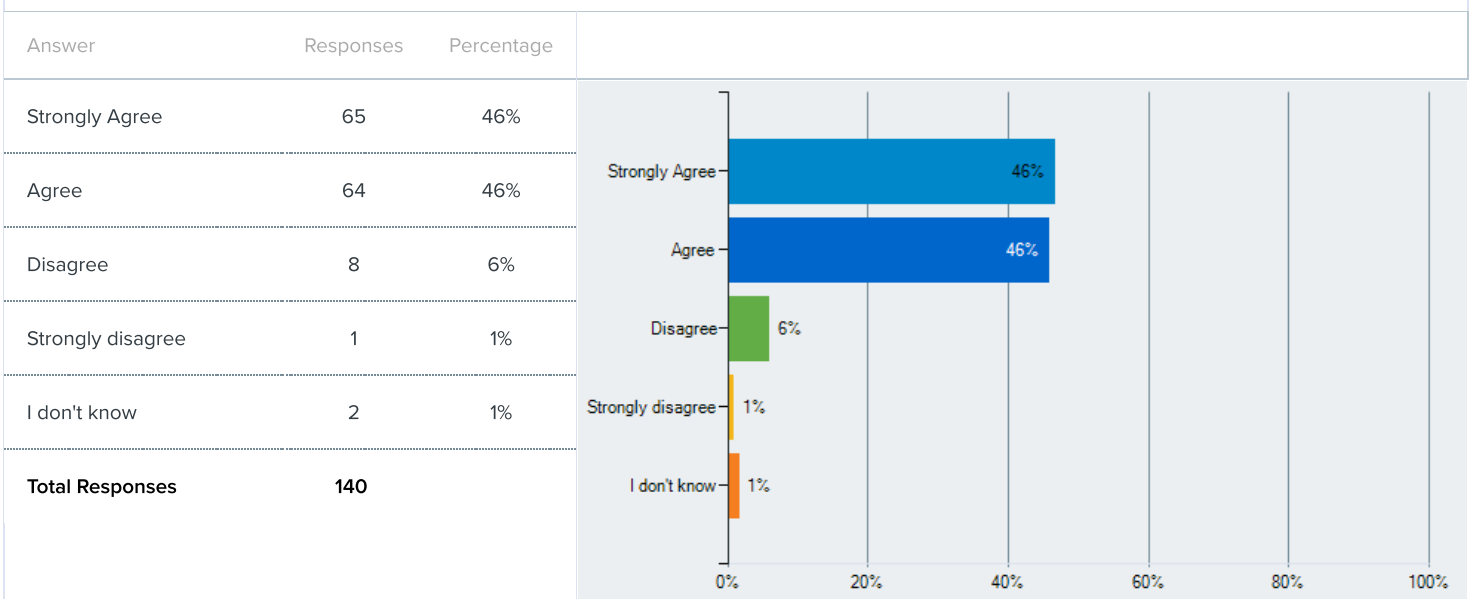




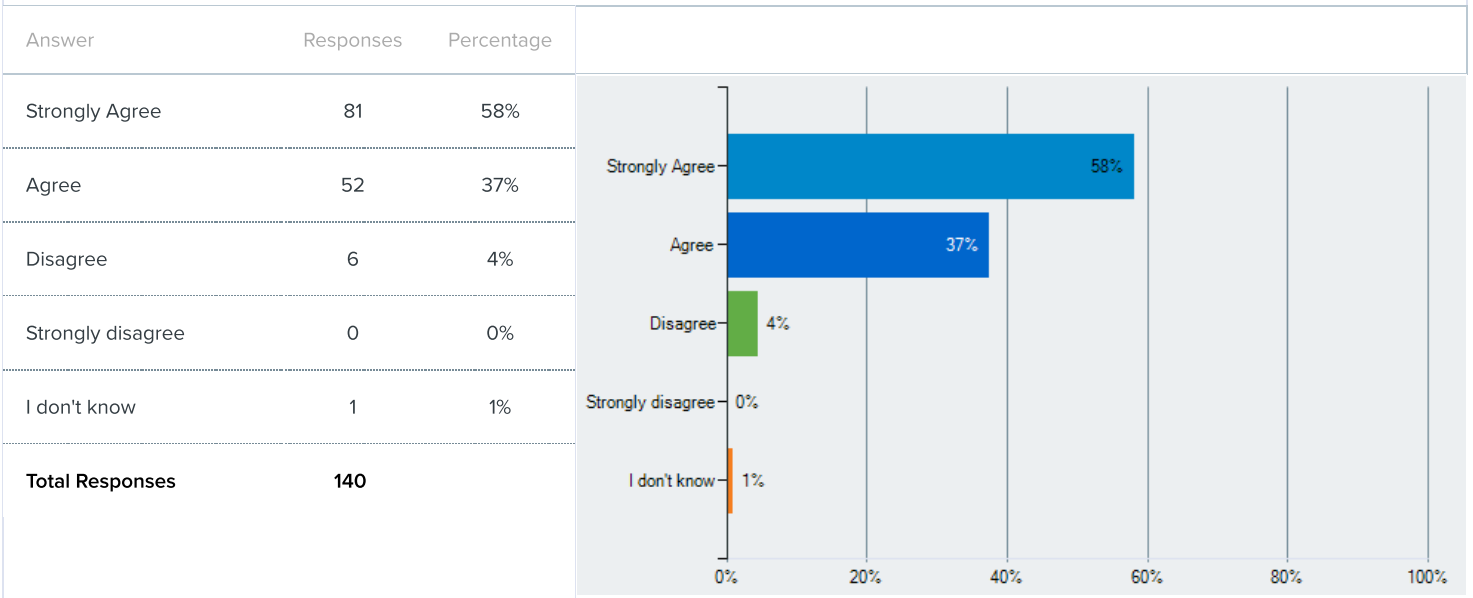

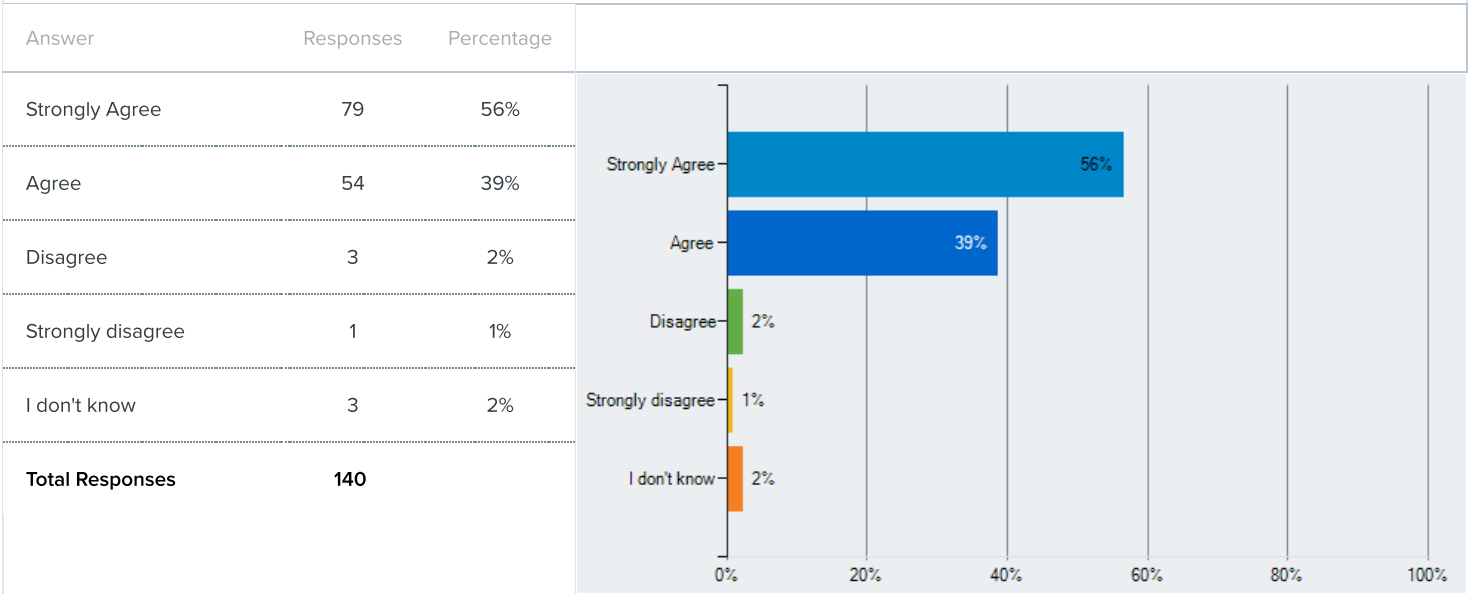

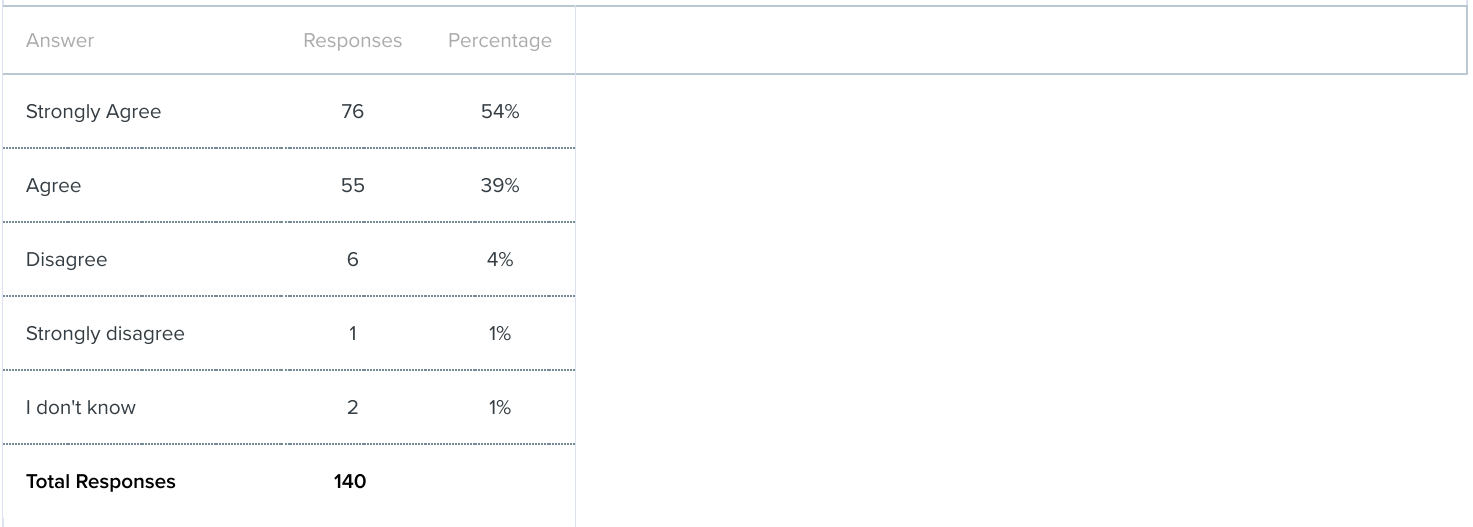

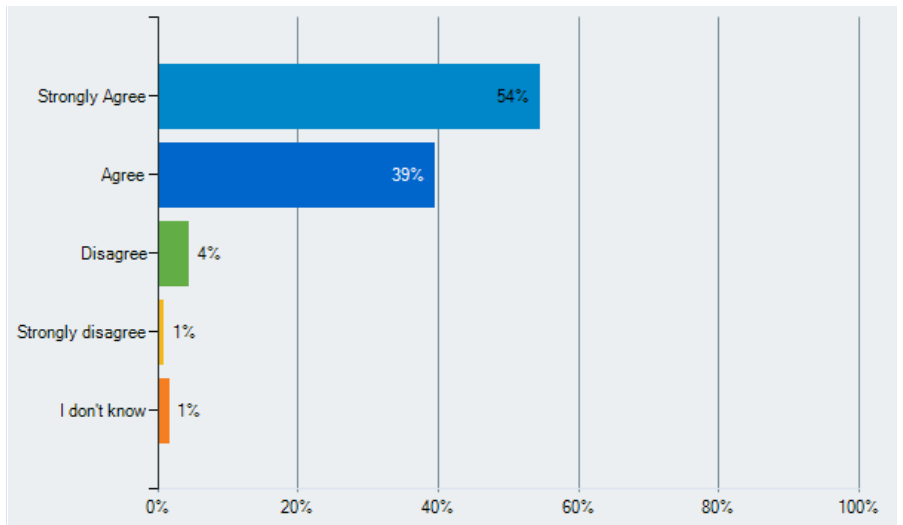


Q 10 The school staff and administration addresses my questions or concerns on a timely basis.

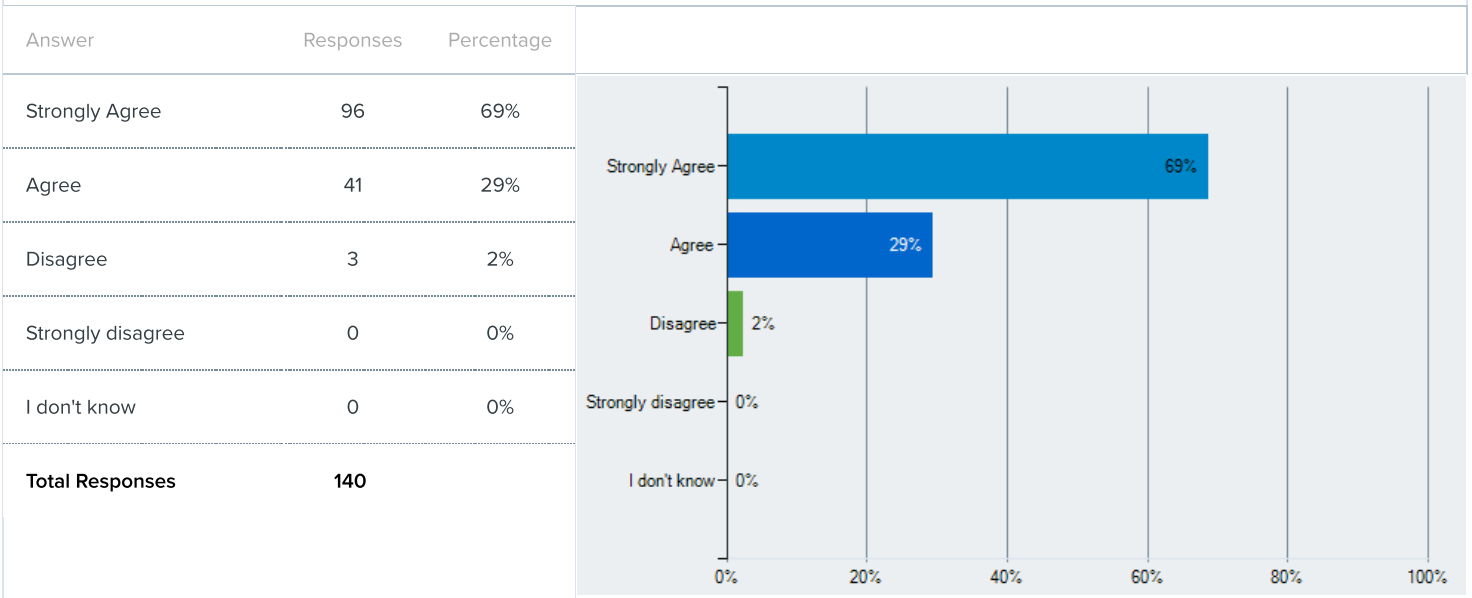

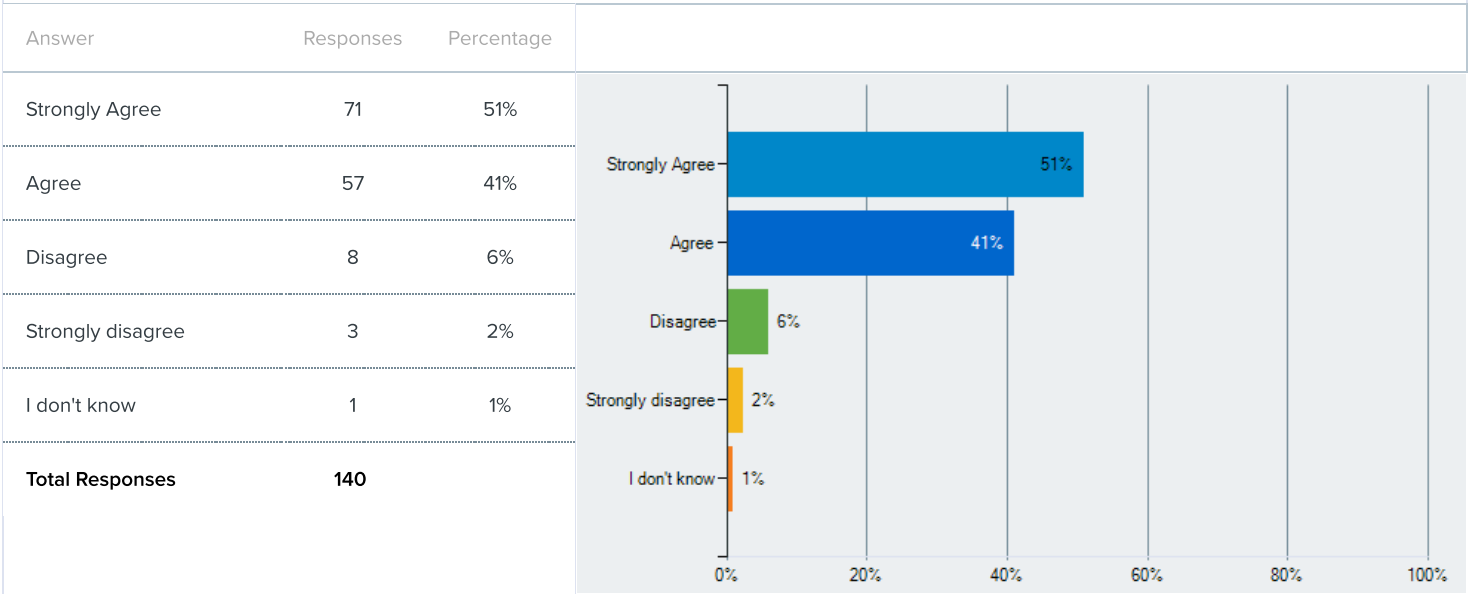

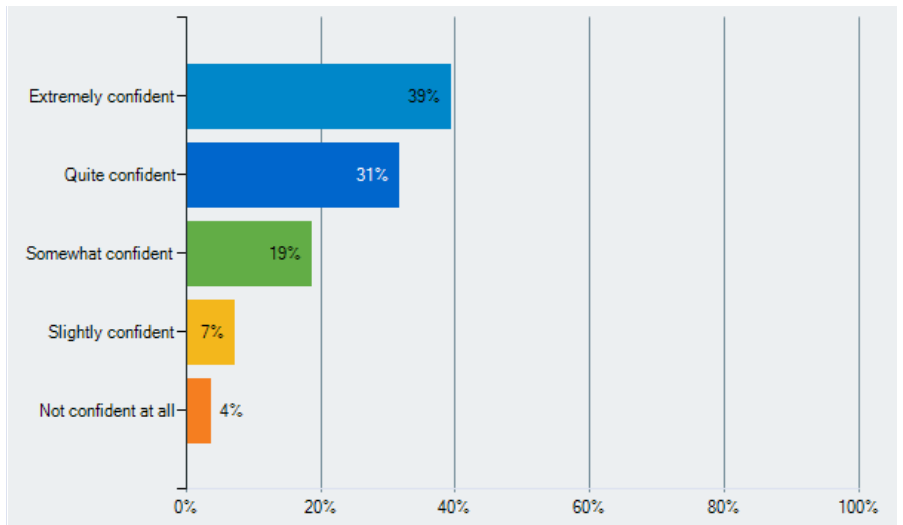


Q 15 There are adequate opportunities for me to express my concerns and opinions about important issues impacting my child.

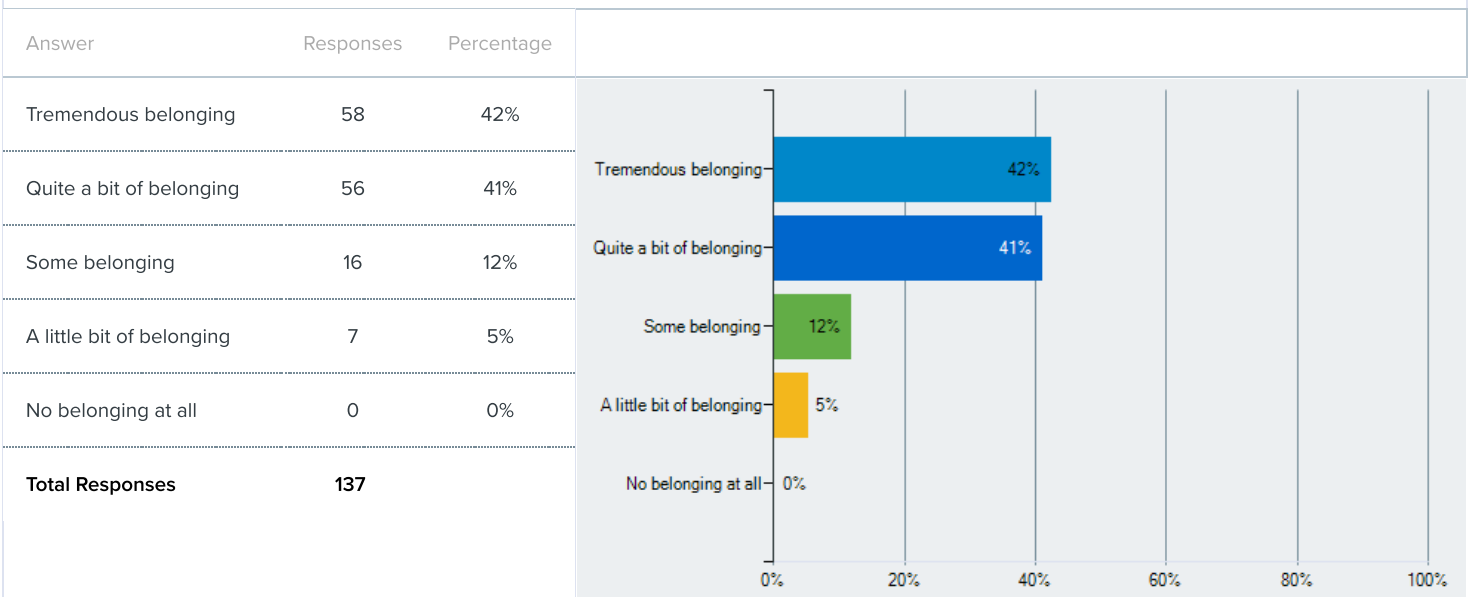


Q 16 How confident are you in your ability to support your child's learning at home?

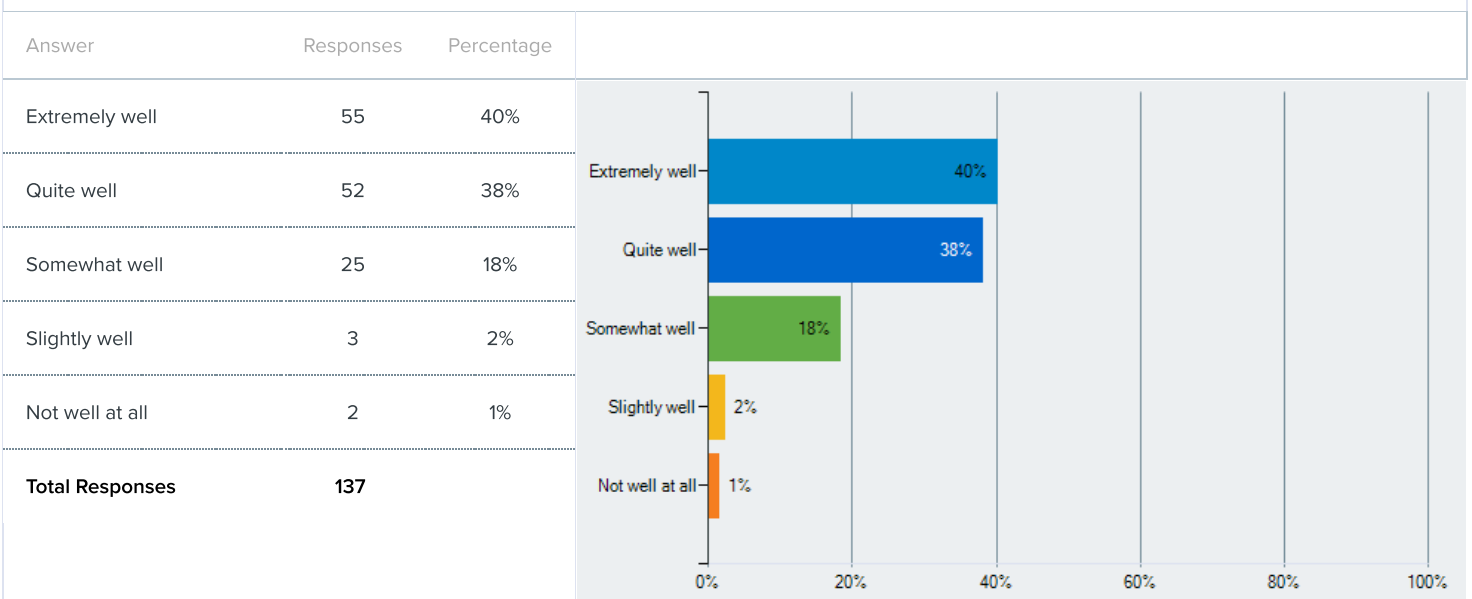




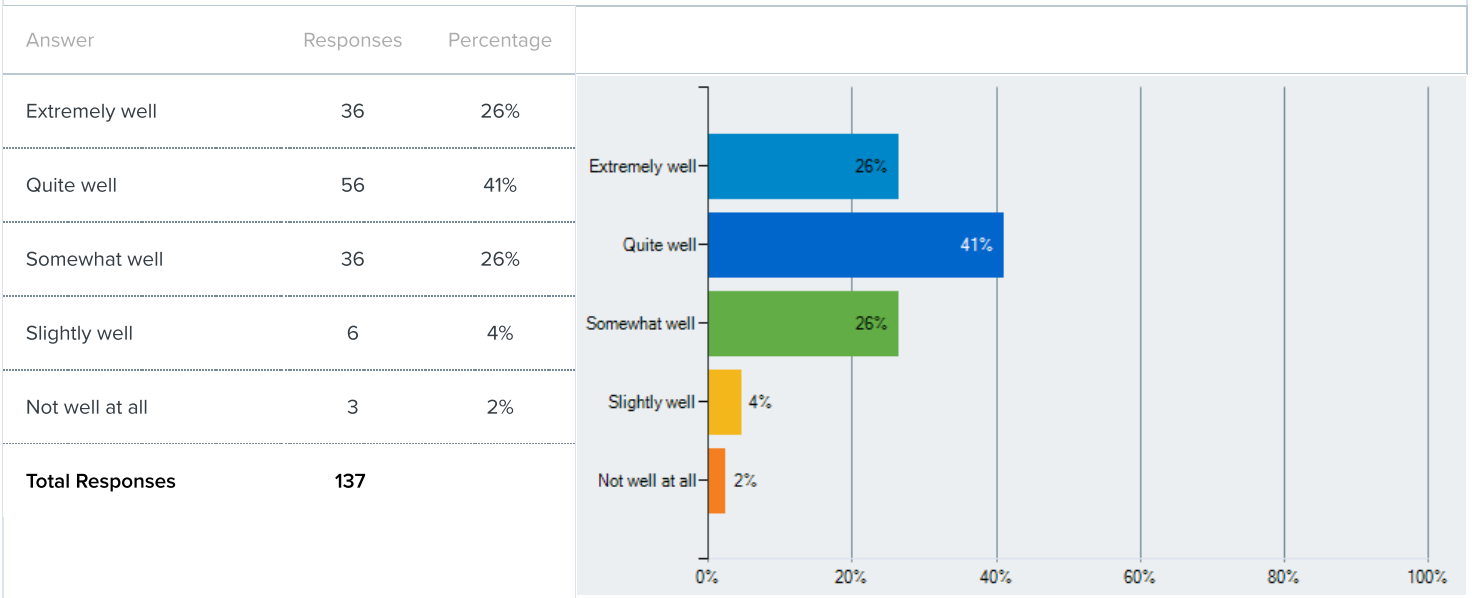
Q 17 How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at their school?



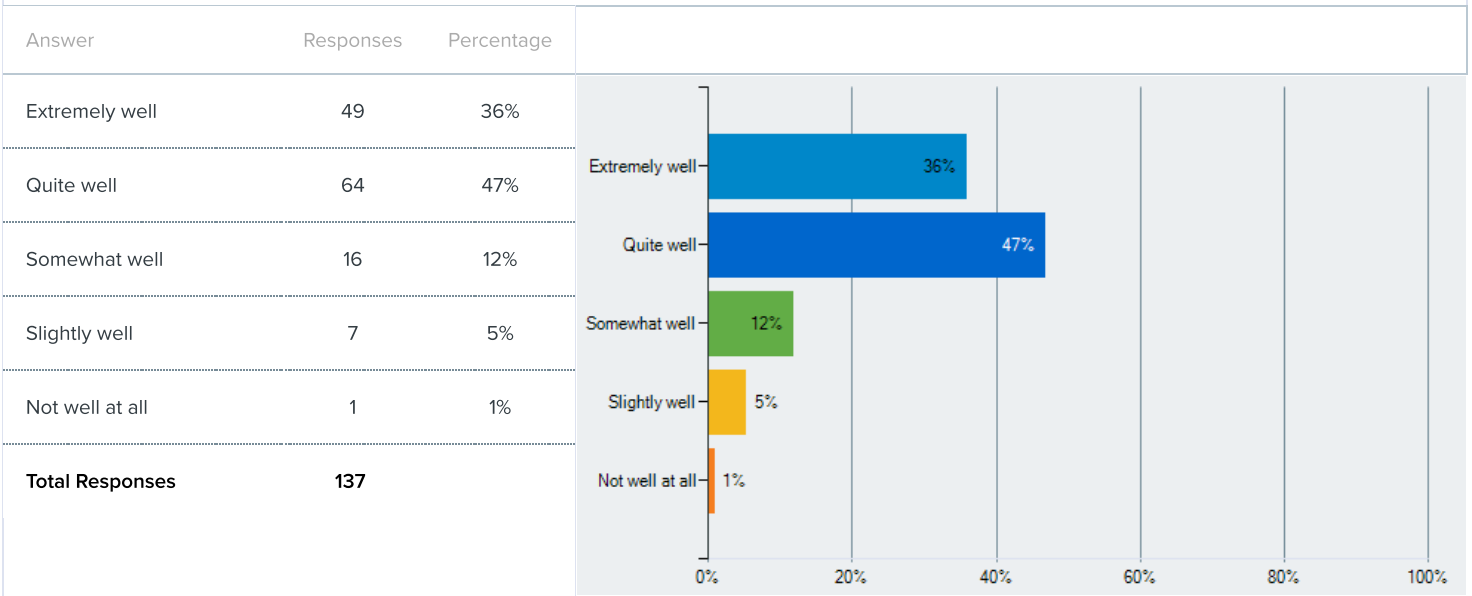
Q 18 How well do you feel your child's school is preparing them for their next academic year?



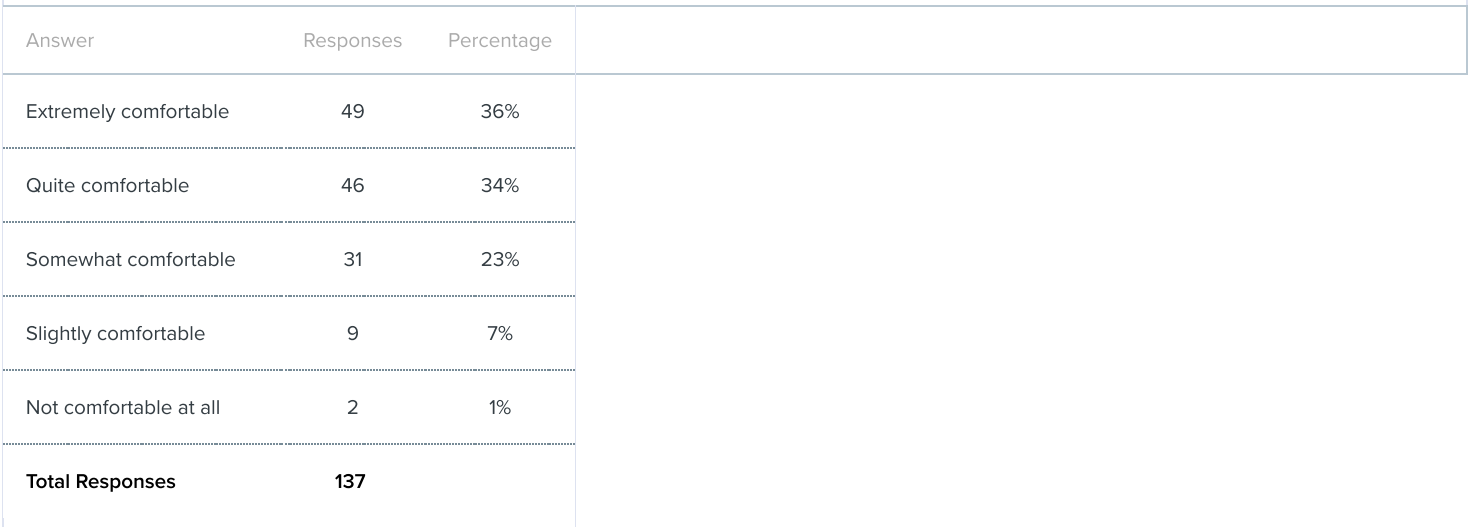
Q 19 How well do the activities offered at your child's school match their interests?

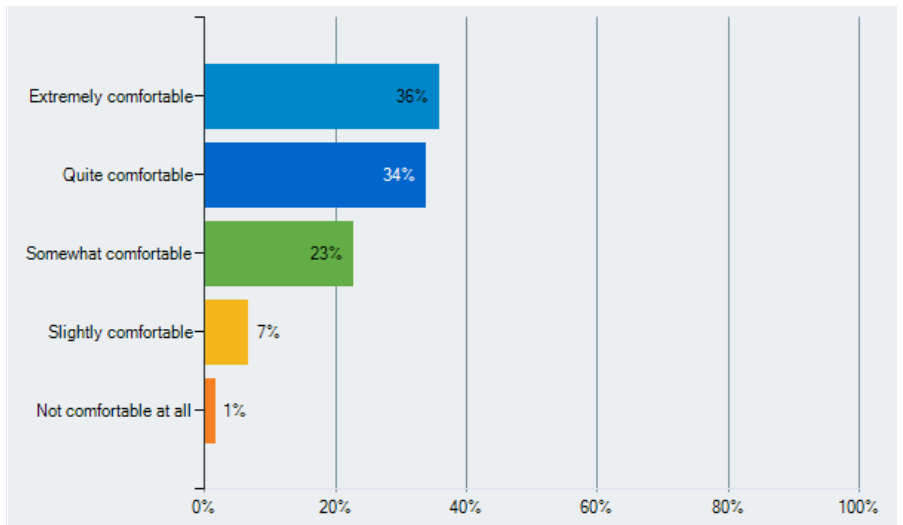


Q 20 At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?

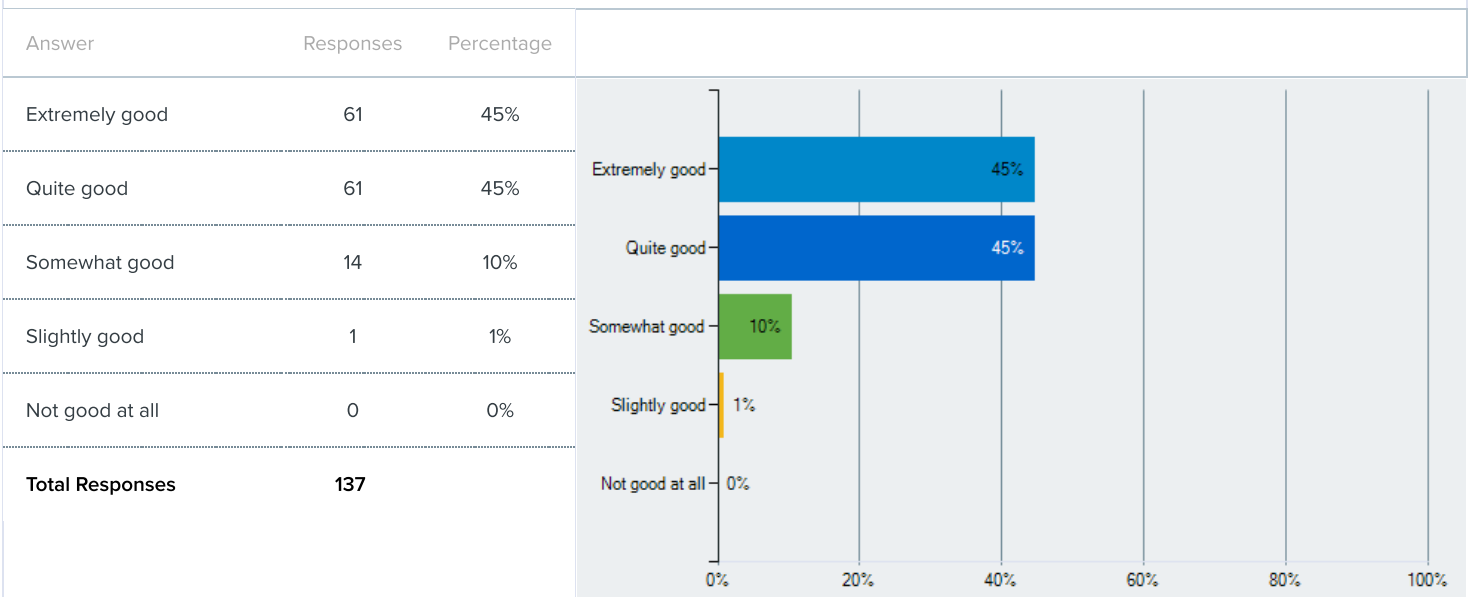


Q 21 How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?

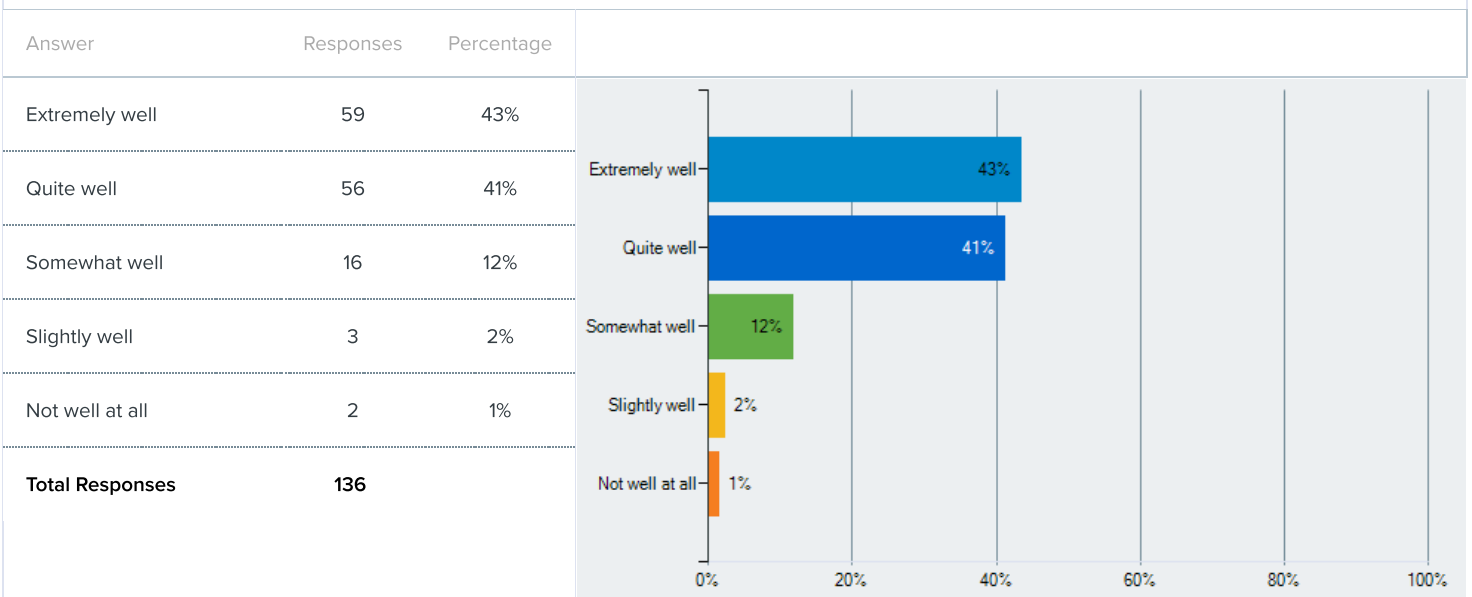




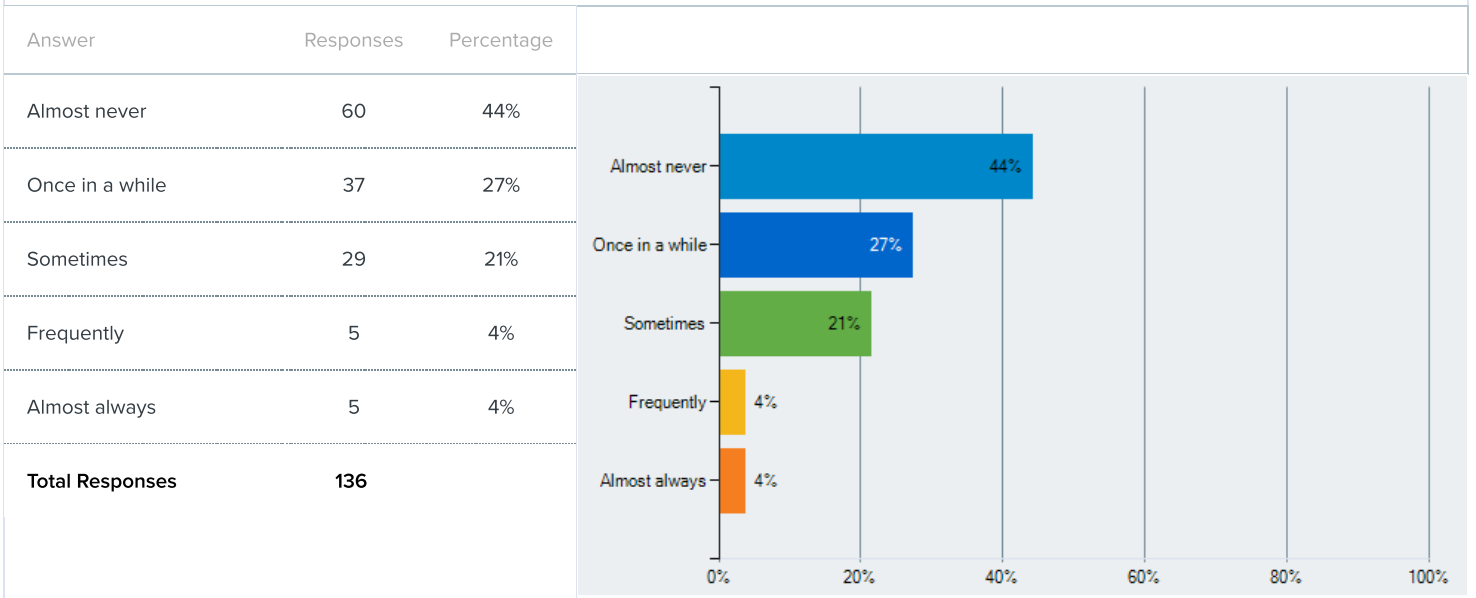
Q 22 Given your child's cultural background, how good a fit is their school?



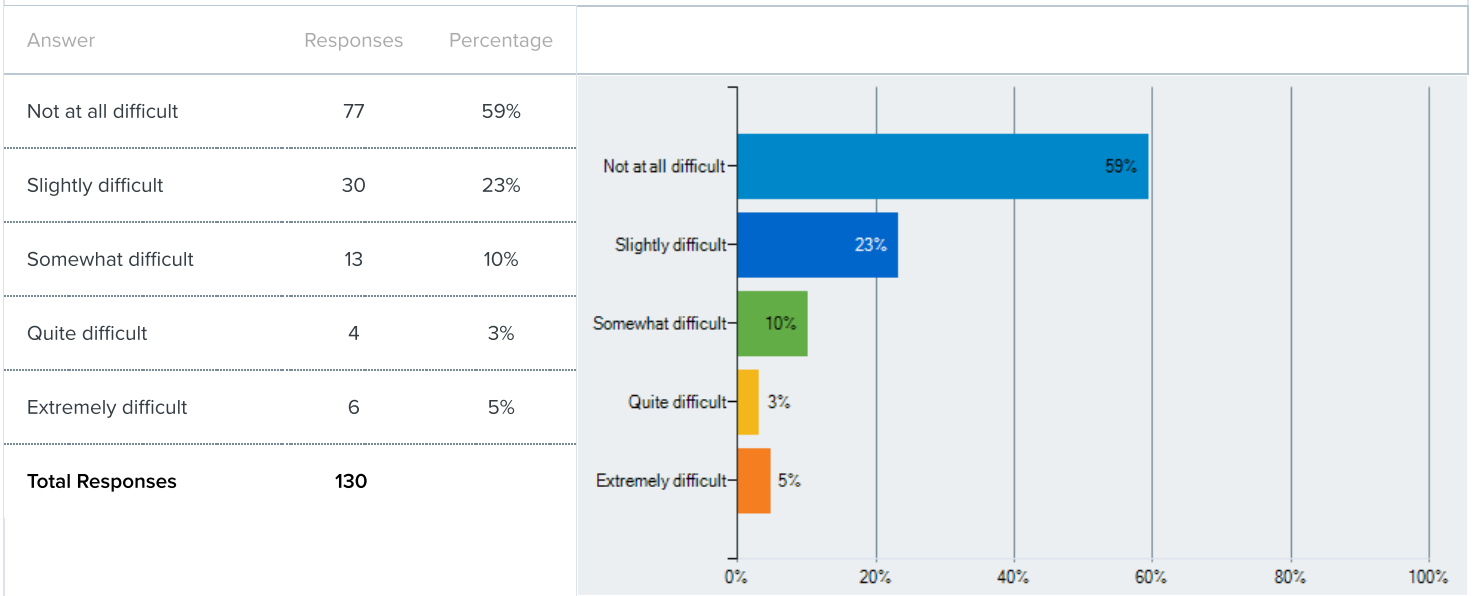
Q 23 How well do the teaching styles of your child's teachers match your child's learning style?



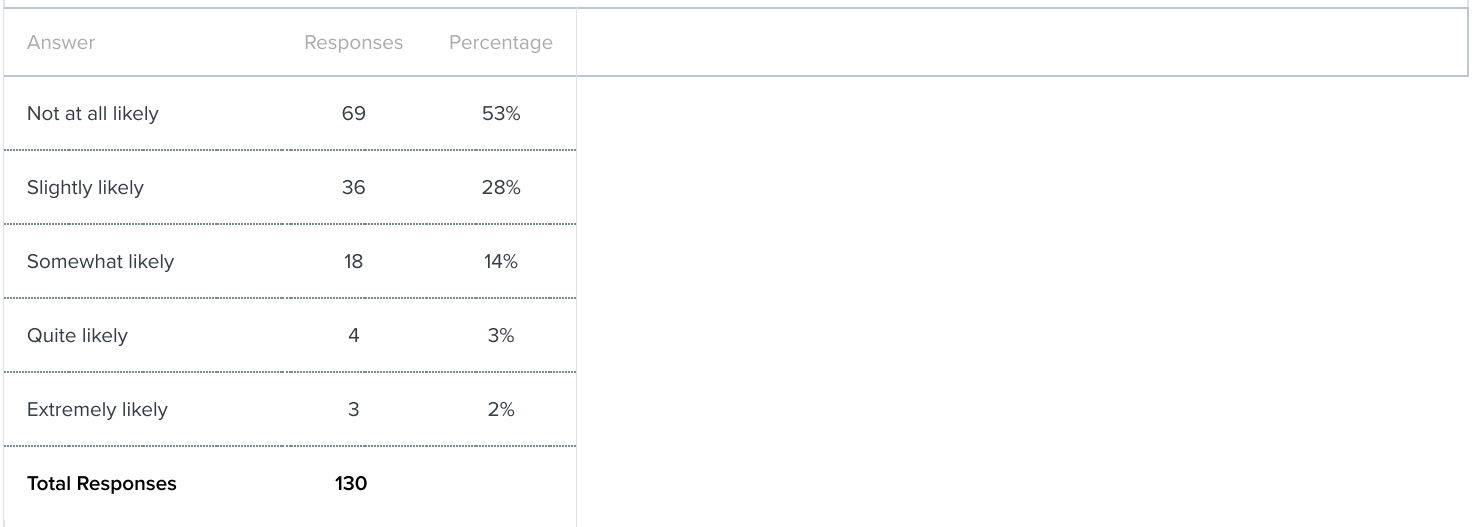
Q 24 How often do you worry about violence at your child's school?

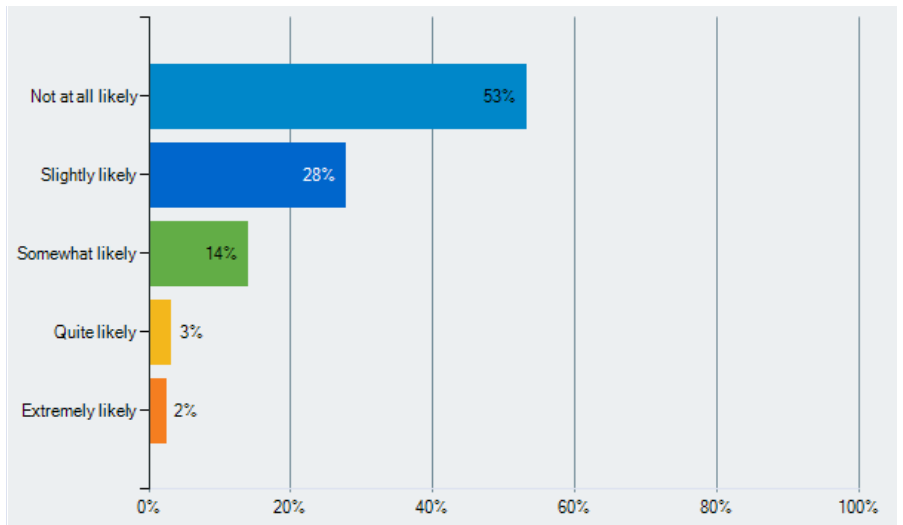


Q 25 If a student is bullied at your child's school, how difficult is it for them to get help from an adult?

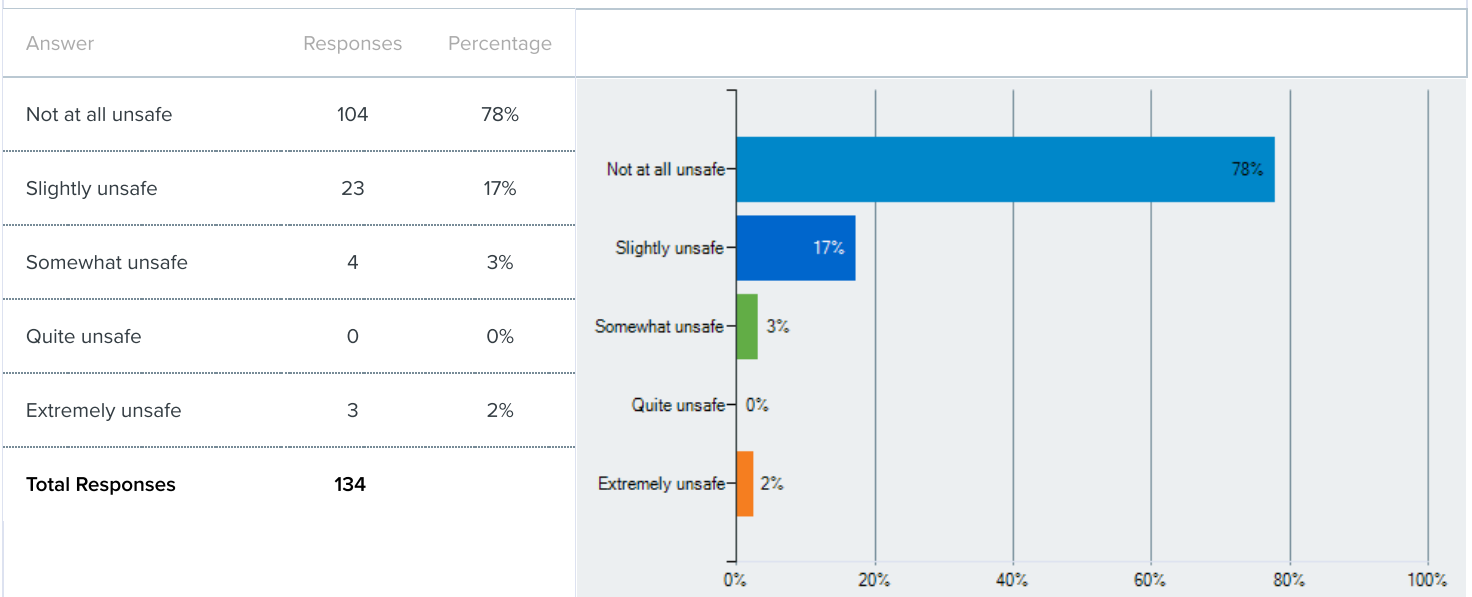


Q 26 How likely is it that someone from your child's school will bully them online?

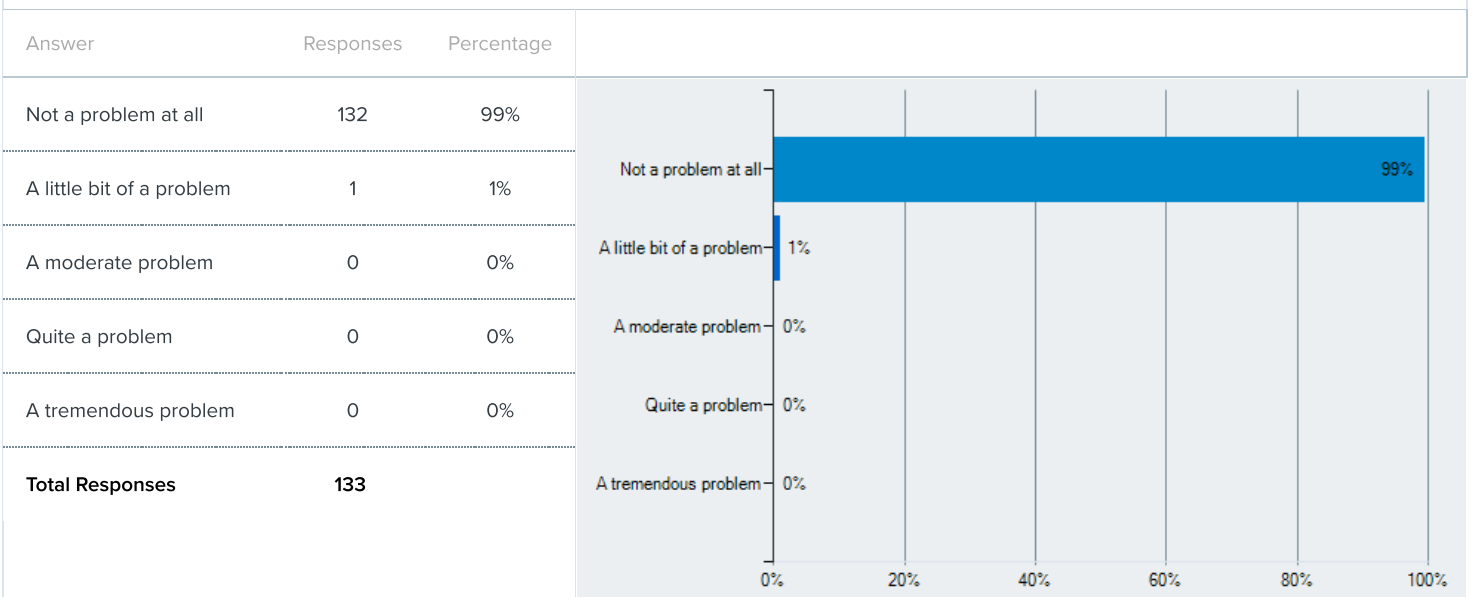




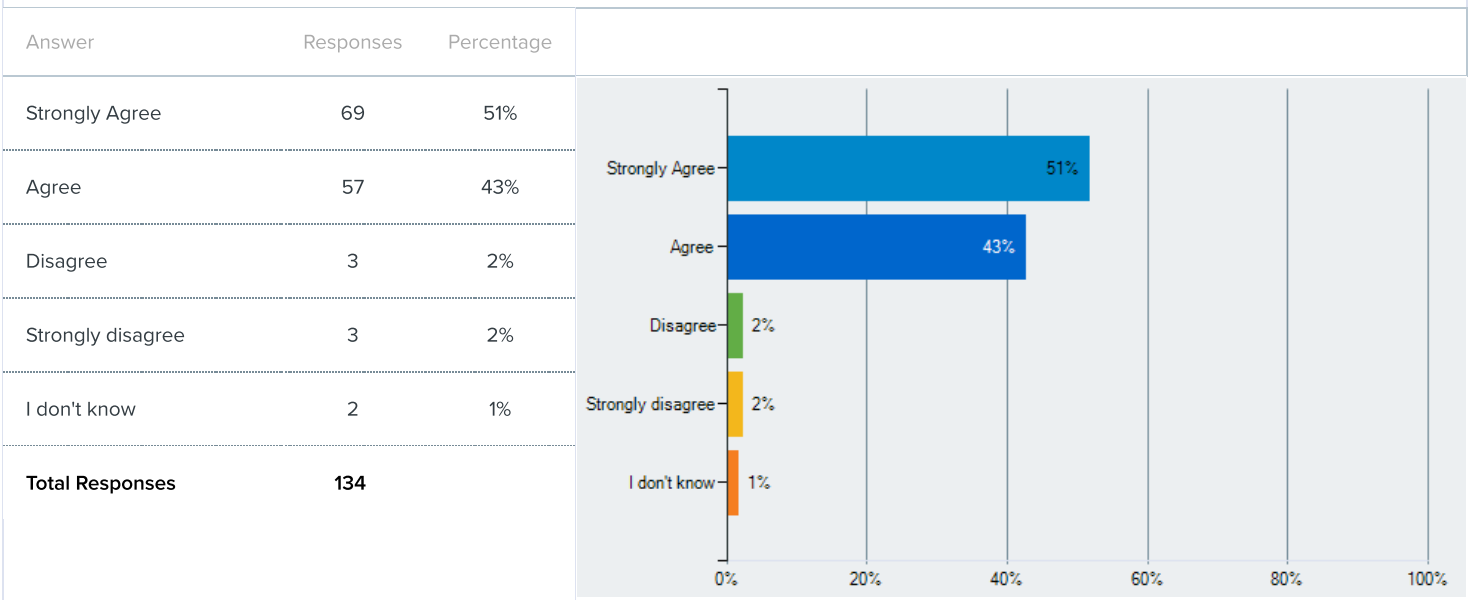
Q 27 Overall, how unsafe does your child feel at school?



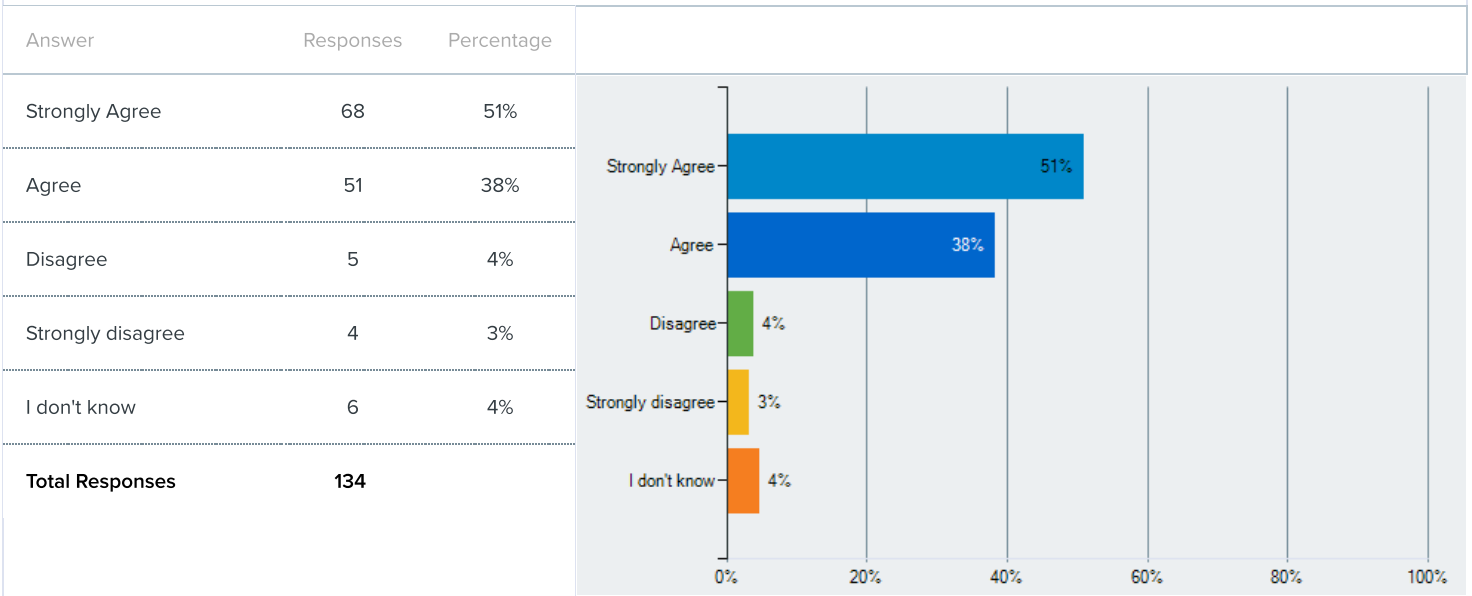
Q 28 To what extent are drugs a problem at your child's school?



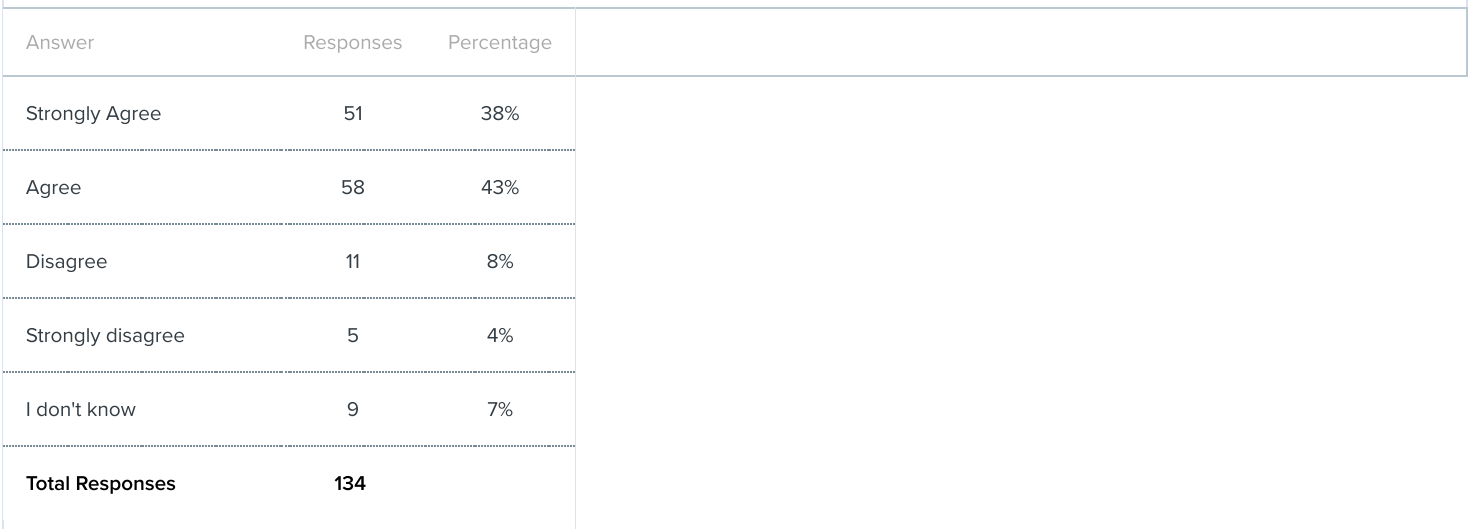
Q 29 Teachers at this school provide my child with high-quality feedback about their academic, social, and behavioral progress.

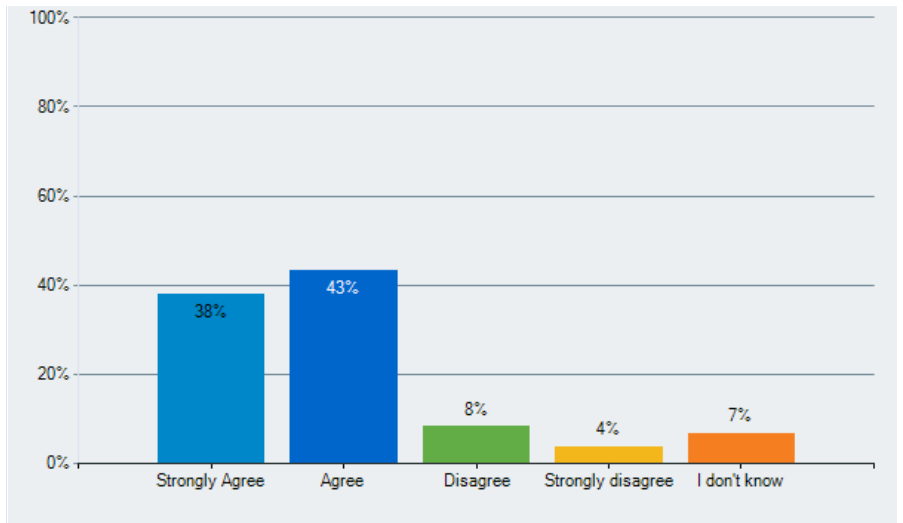


Q 30 My child can get the extra help and resources they need to be successful.

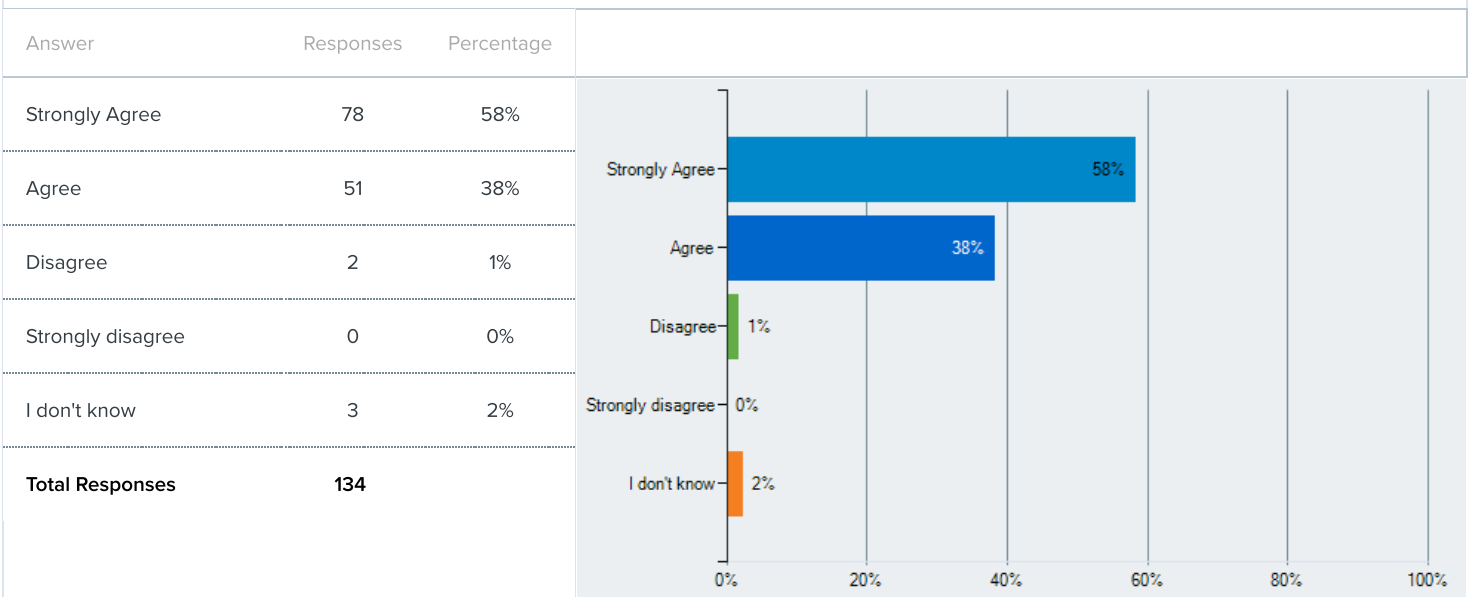


Q 31 My child is challenged to meet high expectations at this school.

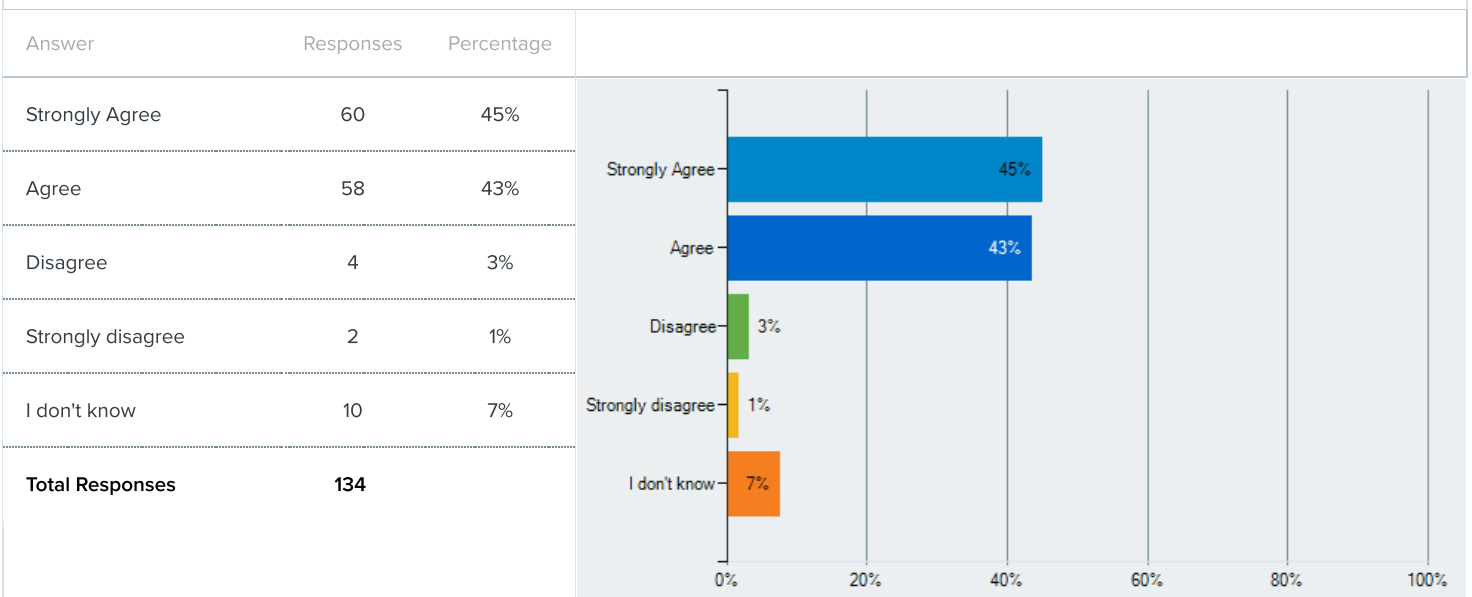




Q 32 My child is taught to respect individual differences at school (gender, race/ethnicity, culture, socio-economics, disability, etc.)
