#### THE RBC CAMPUS IS FAMILIAR TERRAIN FOR JIM GAUL ('76), DIRECTOR OF SAFETY & SECURITY

The legacy of the Gaul family runs deep at RBC. Jim Gaul, our new Director of Safety and Security, is a third generation Casey family member. His grandfather, John P. Gaul, attended RBC (then called St. James High

School) in the early 1900's. His father, Danny, graduated in 1947, a few years later than his class members of '45, as he had an interim period serving in the Navy. Jim's mom, Millie, although not an "official" Casey graduate, was a well known and loved fixture on campus for over 25 years, working in the guidance department and for St. James parish.

The Gaul family resided in Red Bank and Jim and his three sisters, Mary Anne ('78), Clare ('80), and Barbara ('81) attended RBC one after another, leaving their mark as they walked the halls as Caseys. Jim fondly remembers his time on campus in the mid 70's, where the faith, values and traditions instilled in him influenced his career path to serve others. Jim spent his career in law enforcement, first as a Police Officer in Allenhurst for over 27 years, retiring as a Sergeant, and then at Monmouth University as a patrol officer for 15 years.
