2022–2023 CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT



Concurrent enrollment classes are taught through Weber State University, Utah State University, Utah Valley University, and Salt Lake Community College. It is the student’s responsibility to admit to the University offering the class and pay applicable admission fees (\$30 - \$50 depending on the university). Students must be ADMITTED to the university before they can REGISTER for a CE course.

The benefits of concurrent enrollment include:

- (1) Tuition is only \$5/credit hour. Save hundreds of dollars per class.
- (2) Classes are taught at WXHS.
- (3) Students earn high school credit AND university credit for the same class. Graduate from college sooner and get an earlier start on your career.
- (4) Credit is transferrable to other state colleges/universities. Contact private Utah schools (BYU, Westminster) to check transfer equivalency.
- (5) College scholarships available to incoming WSU Freshmen who have completed 12+ concurrent enrollment credits from ANY Utah colleges with a 3.0 GPA will receive a 4 yr/8 semester tuition waiver of \$2,000/yr to WSU.

Important notes:

- (1) Courses with a 'P' listed after the WXHS course name indicate a pure course, meaning that all students in the class MUST be registered at WSU. With all other classes listed, registration is optional. Students will be given high school credit at WXHS but will NOT receive college credit if they do not register at the university.
- (2) Be aware that concurrent credit/grade earned at the university level will be placed on the permanent college transcript.
- (3) Failing or withdrawing after withdrawal date can impact the student's Financial Aid eligibility (FAFSA)
- (4) No more than 20 CE credits can be taken per semester and no more than 30 CE credits per school year.
- (5) If the CE class credit is not going toward a Gen Ed requirement or towards a major program area, it could limit the student's ability to be full time which could affect Financial Aid eligibility.
- (6) Many college majors tell you the exact Gen Ed and Elective courses they want a student to take for the program. Students should check with the university they plan to attend.
- (7) A few courses have required textbooks. That cost will be added to their registration fees and paid to the college.

What is the Certificate of Completion?

The Certificate of Completion (COC) is awarded when students complete all core and breadth requirements with a minimum 2.0 GPA. Once applied for and awarded, it will appear on students’ transcripts and is considered part of their official record. The Certificate allows students to “lock in” their Gen Ed credits and is transferable between institutions in the Utah System of Higher Education. General Education accounts for approximately 36 - 39 credit hours and an Associates degree requires a minimum of 60 credit hours. PLEASE meet with a WSU college academic advisor.
