 - i. 97% of 9th grade students will leave Legacy with sufficient credit in core subject areas: English, math, science, and social studies.
 - ii. Legacy will maintain a course competency pass rate of 94% or above across all courses
 - iii. 85% of Legacy students will set weekly goals and check in with a mentor at least three times per term.
 - iv. Legacy will make gains in reading and math scores. Legacy will decrease the number of students who are below or far below proficiency by three percent in reading and math. On end of year assessments Legacy students will be at or above both state and district averages in competency levels.
