Each advisory will create a visual display to be hung in the hallway illustrating their assigned global issue topic with a memorable graphic representation of the concept. To conclude the project, each grade level will have an opportunity to have a gallery walk of each display with their grade level advisory.

Tutorial:

On Tuesday September 13th we will be starting our after-school tutorial program at Nooksack Valley Middle School. Tutorial runs from 2:15 until 4:00 on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. Students are welcome to stay, but they must make arrangements with their teachers before the end of the school day. Grade level teachers create schedules, and they will let students know when they are staying, and if they are not available, they will let the student know what teacher they are to report to, or if they need to go home for the day when there are not any grade level teachers available.

Transportation home is provided when students stay for tutorial. They will receive a bus slip, from the teacher they are with, to be allowed onto the bus.

If you feel your child needs extra support provided in after school tutorial, it would be helpful to connect with your child's teacher Tuesday night at our Open House, or by emailing your students classroom teacher at their school email address.
