

Poolville ISD Student Drug Testing Consent Form

Poolville ISD requires drug testing of any student in grades 7–12 who chooses to participate in school-sponsored extracurricular activities per Board Policy FNF (LEGAL & LOCAL). “Extracurricular activities” for purposes of this program include athletic programs, cheerleading, literary activities, One Act Play, Academic Decathlon, UIL academic/theater contests, stock showing and other agriculture related activities, any other club or organization that participates in performances, contests, demonstrations or competitions.

A student participating in extracurricular activities is subject to random screenings throughout the school year for the presence of illegal drugs.

Board Policy dictates that regulations for the implementation of the District’s student drug testing program address the following:

1. Covered activities and purpose of the program;
2. Written consent and confidentiality of results;
3. Testing procedures and collection process; and
4. Applicable consequences.
