I'm Chief Petty Officer Ross Woody, the **NROTC Scholarship Program Coordinator** for Washington, Alaska, Montana and Northern Idaho. I take great pride in helping young students find solutions to the high cost of college education. The NROTC Scholarship Program offers students the opportunity to earn their degree and receive valuable leadership and management skills while enjoying the benefits of an exciting career. The basic requirements and benefits of this outstanding program are listed below.

#### 1. **Selected applicants receive:**

- Full tuition and other financial benefits worth up to \$200,000. NROTC Units are located at over 150 of the nation's leading colleges and universities.
- \$250-\$400 a month tax-free spending money. \$750 stipend per year for books.

#### 2. **Basic eligibility requirements:**

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- At least 17 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and less than 23 on December 31<sup>st</sup>, of the year you start college.
- Graduate high school by August 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of entrance into the scholarship program
- Take the SAT or ACT test prior to application deadline, and receive at least the minimum scores:

**SAT**  
Math = 540  
EBRW = 550  
Combined minimum = 1100

**ACT**  
Math = 21  
English = 22  
Combined minimum = 44

#### 3. **May apply for one of these options:**

- NAVY
  - Programs include Surface, Submarine, EOD, SEAL, Aviation (Pilot & NFO)
- NURSE
  - Must major in a nursing degree program leading to a BSN

#### 4. **Degree requirements:**

- Major in any field (except for Nurse, must get BSN)
- Normal Course load
- Complete the following courses: Calculus\*, Physics\*, National Security Policy or American Military Affairs\*, English grammar and composition, World Culture and Regional Studies, and Nine (9) Naval Science Courses.  
\*Not required for Nurse ROTC

#### 5. **Military Service requirements:**

- No obligation for your first year of college
- Upon completion of degree, receive commission as an Ensign in the US Navy
- Navy Option has 5 year Active duty commitment. Nursing has 4 year Active duty commitment.

#### 6. **Benefits of NROTC:**

- Free college tuition
- Guaranteed job upon graduation
- Opportunity to lead and manage personnel
- Unlimited travel opportunities
- 30 days paid vacation earned annually
- Free medical and dental

According to the Society for Human Resources, the average starting salary for the college Class of 2020 was **\$55,260**.  
Meanwhile, a Navy Ensign living in San Diego in 2022, is making **\$74,535.60** annually!
